



AUTHORS' SNAPSHOTS - JUSTICE KIM SATHAVY AND MR. LY TAYSENG

Justice Kim Sathavy has served as a Honorable Justice of the Supreme Court since May 2006; the Director of Royal School for Judges and Prosecutors from 2002-2005; legal advisor to Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Interior from 1999-2002; advisor to Minister of Justice in charge of training judges and prosecutors from 1995-1997; and the vice-president of the Siem Reap Provincial Court from 1986-1993. She was appointed as a judge of Siem Reap Provincial Court in 1982.

Justice Kim graduated from University Lumière Lyon 2 with a bachelor of law degree in, completed judicial training at Ecole Nationale de la Magistrature in Bordeaux (France) from 1993-1995. From 1997-1998, she was a visiting scholar at University of Michigan Law School Ann Arbor.

Mr Ly Tayseng is admitted to practice law in Cambodia and has served as Secretary General of the Bar Association of the Kingdom of Cambodia since 2004. He has also held the positions of: legal and political search assistant and analyst to the Supreme National Economics Council under the Prime Minister's Office from 2005; assistant to Justice Kim Sathavy, director of Royal School for Judges and Prosecutors from 2003 to 2004; and a visiting lecturer at law at Royal University of Law and Economics.

Mr Ly graduated with a Cambodian bachelor of law degree from Royal University of Law and Economics, a French bachelors degree of law from University Lumière Lyon 2 (France), and an LL.M from Graduate School of Law, Nagoya University (Japan) in 2003.
