BIKING in WASHINGTON PARK

Terrain & Bike Paths
There are limited designated biking lanes in the Park. Expect to share the road with vehicles. The terrain varies widely and can be steep in some areas, especially along SW Kingston Dr. and SW Fairview Blvd.

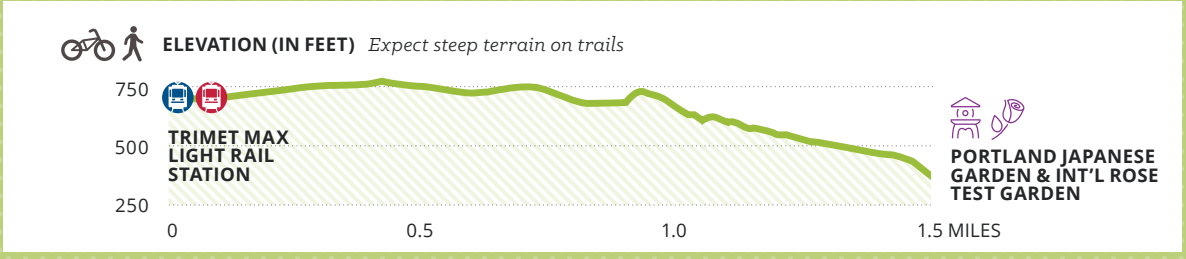
- FREE BIKE PARKING for personal bicycles. \$1 in-network charge for BIKETOWN parking.
