RESOLUTION NO. 2017-164

DECLARING NASHE ENTERPRISES AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER IN THE PROCUREMENT OF 42 UNITS 7.62mm LIGHT MACHINE GUN UNDER PUBLIC BIDDING NO. PNP-17-69G, AND RECOMMENDING TO THE HEAD OF THE PROCURING ENTITY THE AWARD OF CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the PNP through Republic Act (RA) No. 10924 otherwise known as the "General Appropriations Act of 2017" has sourced the amount of Forty Six Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos [Php46,200,000.00] for the procurement of 42 units 7.62mm Light Machine Gun;

WHEREAS, the PNP advertised the Invitation to Bid in the Philippine Star, and posted the same in the PNP website, the PhilGEPS website, and the NHQ BAC Bulletin Board on November 30, 2017 under Public Bidding No. PNP-2017-69G;

WHEREAS, the Bid Opening on December 19, 2017 was participated in by two (2) bidders, to wit:

JV of R. Espineli Trading & Israel Weapons Industries, Ltd.	46,195,800.00	2 nd LCB

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group on Financial and Technical Documents Evaluation (TWG-FTDE) conducted the evaluation on the legal, technical and financial documents of the LCB and submitted its Report with the following observations hereto quoted thus:

"OBSERVATION:

After the conduct of post qualification on the documents submitted, the TWG on FTDE determined that the bidder, the Nashe Enterprises complied with all the Eligibility, Technical, and Financial requirements."

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group for Test and Evaluation of Equipment (TWG-TEE) on Weapons conducted the evaluation on the Brochure of the aforesaid LCB and submitted its Report with the following observations hereto quoted thus:

"FINDINGS:

The Brochures and Checklist of Compliance to Technical Specifications submitted by Nashe Enterprises are 'CONFORMING' pursuant to NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 95-069 entitled: 'Approving the Standard Specifications in the Procurement of PNP Anti-Terrorist Equipment.'

WHEREAS, the Committee after careful evaluation resolved to adopt the above observations of the TWG-FTDE and findings of the TWG-TEE on Weapons to form part of this Resolution;

WHEREAS, Section 34.4 of the RIRR of RA No. 9184 provides that "If the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid passes all the criteria for post-qualification, it shall **declare** the said bid as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid/Highest Rated Responsive Bid, and **recommend** to the Head of the Procuring Entity the award of contract to the said bidder at its submitted bid price or its calculated bid price, whichever is lower or, in the case of quality-based evaluation procedure, submitted bid price or its negotiated price, whichever is lower";

WHEREFORE, after careful deliberation, this Committee resolved as it hereby resolves to:

1. **DECLARE** the **Nashe Enterprises** as the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder** in the procurement of **42 units 7.62mm Light Machine Gun** under Public Bidding No. PNP-17-69G; and

2. **RECOMMEND** to the HOPE the **APPROVAL** of the **Award of Contract to Nashe Enterprises** in the procurement of **42 units 7.62mm Light Machine Gun** under Public Bidding No. PNP-17-69G for a contract price of **Thirty Eight Million Three Hundred Eighty Eight Thousand Pesos [Php38,388,000.00]**.




