Outline Description	Chapel of the Pieta
Property Description	This church was built in 1865 by Canon Antonio Demajo Albanese who contributed to its construction, together with farmers of the area. Ferris refers to a church of St Anne, which most probably refers to this church. This church has 4 Doric columns supporting an angular pediment with a cross on the pinnacle. The columns form a portico at the entrance of the church. The door has a broken pediment. It has 2 belfries on each side of the building and a coat of arms on each side of the facade, below the belfries.

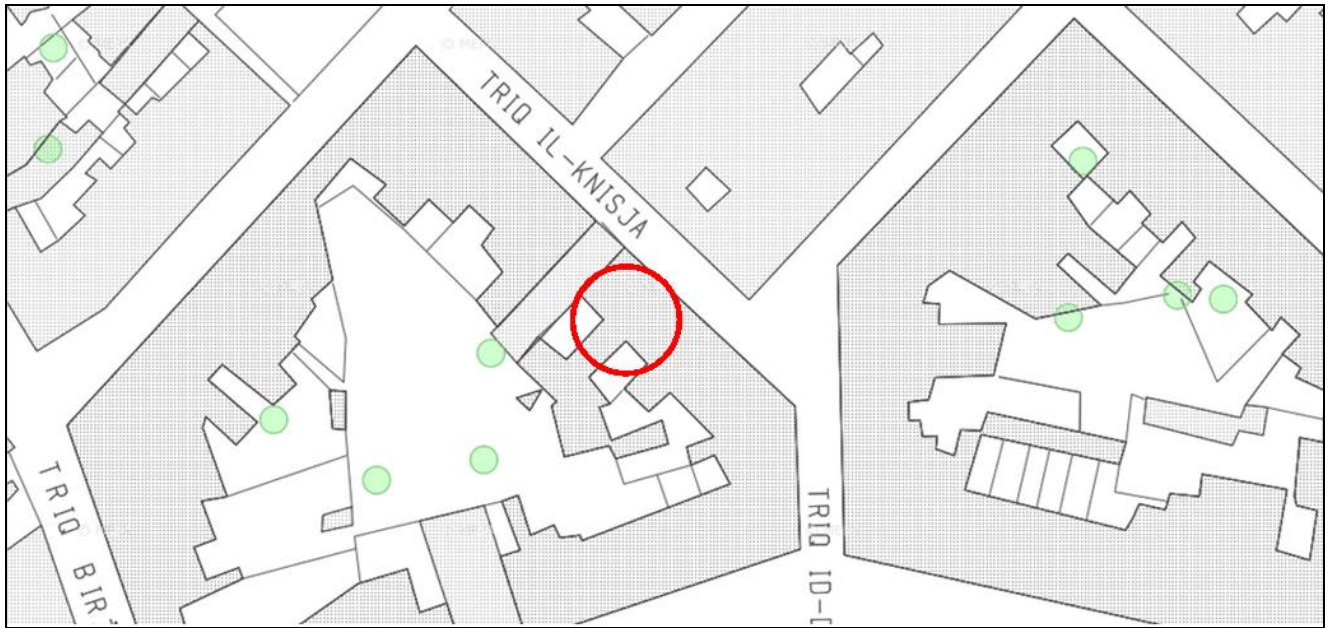
