Players and all members of the national delegation shall hold valid insurance for damages of any nature caused to third parties. Such insurance shall cover bodily injury, including medical and hospitalisation expenses incurred in the host country, as well as all expenses and costs associated to repatriating the injured party to its country of residence and/or costs associated if diagnosed COVID-19 positive or self-quarantine measures imposed if a person has to self-isolate/quarantine because he/she is a direct contact as per BWF safety protocols. Also see Insurance under COVID-19 Protocols.

Indemnity

To the extent permitted by applicable law, all players and members of the national delegation shall release the BWF, the Tournament Organiser, and their respective officers, officials, employees, agents and representatives, from any and all liability, damage, loss, cost or expense that such players and members of the national delegation may incur as a result or in connection with their participation to the Tournament.

Participant Agreement for Use of Photographs and Videos Players and all members of the national delegation shall agree to give the BWF and the Tournament Organiser full television and motion picture rights, including permission to film players and members of the national delegation during all matches and activities around the Tournament, for any commercial, news or other purpose together with the right to transfer such right, including without compensation.

















# 2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play)

This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), and BWF World Tour Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.

This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. This includes restrictions of certain colours for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.

After the entry deadline, the BWF Online Group Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries.

Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday, 23 February 2022 at 12:00 hrs Kuala Lumpur time.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, 24 February 2022 at 23:59 hrs Kuala Lumpur time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

Online Entry – Hosting Member Association Entries

Eligible player wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association must follow a different process to international entries.

Entry fees for host members: Single: 70 euros per player

Double: 60 euros per player per event

Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

If a Member Association needs to withdraw any entries once players have arrived in the host city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager in person to the Tournament Referee, or Deputy Referee(s), and must also be confirmed in writing to:

It is mandatory for all participating Member Associations (represented by designated Team Manager) to attend the Team Managers' Meeting. Member Associations will be penalised for failing to attend, in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

















Member Associations are allowed to request representation by another Member Association, provided that the Tournament Referee is notified in advance and approves.

# Presentation Ceremonies

All prize ceremonies will take place on Sunday, 3 April 2022, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/other will be presented to all champions and finalists.

In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statue 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organisers regarding ceremony protocol.

No equipment, including rackets and flags, are allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR.

### Accreditation

Access to Tournament venues and other services is provided through personalised and photographic accreditation.

Accreditation will only be issued after a player/entourage/official.

A limited number of additional accreditation passes for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of 150,00€, charged to the respective Member Association, and payable at the tournament.

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be 100,00€ on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association accepts no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late or refused visa applications.

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge.

Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into France; the final decision is made by the Government of France.

















UPDATED
COVID-19
Protocols

As of 09 February 2022, the French Government has changed the entry requirements to France. The requirements vary based on where travellers are traveling to France from (Green/Amber/Red countries), as well as their vaccination status.

### Country classification:

- a) "Green list" countries or territories: Countries or territories where no active circulation of the virus is observed and no variant of concern is identified. These are the countries in the European area, plus Bahrain, Honduras, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Kuwait, New Zealand, Qatar, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Taiwan, United Arab Emirates and Vanuatu.
- **b)** "Amber list" countries: Countries where active circulation of the virus is observed in controlled proportions, without spread of any variants of concern. These are all countries not included in the "green" and "red" list countries.
- c) "Red list" countries: Countries where active circulation of the virus is observed with the presence of variants of concern. To date, there are no countries classified as "red".

### Vaccination status classification:

The vaccination schedule is considered complete 28 days after receiving one dose of Janssen vaccine, seven days after a second dose of other vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency (namely Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna, AstraZeneca/Vaxzevria/Covishield).

For persons who have received all the required doses of a WHO-licensed vaccine not approved by the European Medicines Agency (Sinopharm/Sinovac), it is considered seven days after receiving an additional dose of a duly approved mRNA (Pfizer/Moderna) vaccine.

The measures applied to vaccinated adults are extended under the same conditions to their accompanying minors, whether vaccinated or not.

**Fully vaccinated:** In order to be considered as fully vaccinated, persons aged eighteen or over wishing to enter the national territory must have:

- a) received their second dose of EMA approved vaccine within the last 9 months without receiving any additional dose of vaccination
- b) received all the required doses of an EMA approved vaccine and also received a dose of complementary messenger RNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna) no later than 9 months following the injection of the last required dose
- c) received all the required doses of a WHO-licensed vaccine not approved by the European Medicines Agency <u>and</u> then received an additional dose of a duly approved mRNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna) and minimum seven days have passed since the receipt of the mRNA vaccine

### Not fully vaccinated:

- a) Those who received their second dose of EMA approved vaccine more than 9 months ago, but have not received a dose of complementary messenger RNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna)
- b) Those who received all the required doses of an EMA approved vaccine, but their 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of vaccination was NOT a messenger RNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna)
- c) Those who are vaccinated with WHO approved vaccines, not approved by the EMA and have not received a dose of complementary messenger RNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna)

















d) Those who are vaccinated with vaccines only approved in their country (which are currently not approved by WHO or EMA) in the correct required number of doses (for instance Sputnik vaccine with 2 doses).

### Not vaccinated:

Participants who are not vaccinated as described above will not be considered as being "Vaccinated" by the French Authorities and must follow the rules specified for "Not vaccinated" people and as such will not be able to participate in the tournament.

### People who have previously been infected with COVID-19:

There is no "vaccine exemption" for non-French people who have previously been infected with COVID-19. If not vaccinated as described above, participants must follow the rules specified for "Not vaccinated" people and as such will not be able to participate in the tournament.

### Condition to access the competition venue:

Non-vaccinated participants will not have access to the competition venue, therefore <u>are not able to participate</u> in the tournament.

### Not fully vaccinated participants will have to respect the following protocols:

- a) <u>Strictly use official transport</u> between the airport/station and Orléans + between the hotel and the venue
- b) <u>Strictly stay either in their hotel room or in the venue</u> and eat either at the venue or in their hotel room. Not allowed to go to public places.
- c) Take an antigenic test every 24h, starting when arriving in Orléans, at their own expenses (in case of a positive antigen test, the result will be confirmed by a PCR test. If the PCR test is positive, the participant will have to isolate in his/her room for 7 to 10 days, at his/her own expense)

  Their identified close contacts will have to follow the local health authority regulations and the BWF COVID-19 protocols:
  - Definition of close contacts: roommates and/or double partners
  - Vaccinated close contacts: mandatory daily antigenic test at own cost. If the test results are negative, no mandatory self-isolation. If one of the tests turns out to be positive, mandatory 7 days self-isolation (can be reduced to 5 days self-isolation if no symptoms and a negative test at Day 5).
  - Not (fully) vaccinated close contacts: mandatory 7 days self-isolation + antigenic test at the end of this period.

Participants who belong to the "not fully vaccinated category" must arrive to Orleans on time for their onarrival antigen test result to be received before the start for the TMM. However, should a participant test positive on the said antigen-test, a follow up PCR test will be carried out. The result of this PCR test must be received in order to play or practice, so kindly factor this in for your arrival time. (The PCR result test can take up to 24hours to receive.)

















### Fully vaccinated participants

Participants considered as "EMA fully vaccinated" as defined above will be allowed to access the venue and other public places by showing their proof of vaccination (ideally the related QR Code to ease the process) every time they enter these places. No on-arrival testing will be carried out for those who are fully vaccinated.

### Vaccination status:

The vaccination schedule is considered complete 28 days after receiving one dose of Janssen vaccine, seven days after a second dose of other vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency (namely

















Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna, AstraZeneca/Vaxzevria/Covishield) and, for persons who have received all the required doses of a WHO licensed vaccine not approved by the European Medicines Agency, seven days after receiving an additional dose of a duly approved mRNA vaccine.

The measures applied to vaccinated adults are extended under the same conditions to their accompanying minors, whether vaccinated or not.

Participants who are not vaccinated as descripted above will not be considered as being "Vaccinated" by the French Authorities and must follow the rules specified for "Not vaccinated" people.

### Country classification:

- "Green list" countries or territories: Countries or territories where no active circulation of the virus is observed and no variant of concern is identified. These are the countries in the European area, plus Argentina, Australia, Bahrain, Hong Kong, Japan, Kuwait, New Zealand, Qatar, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Taiwan, United Arab Emirates, Uruguay and Vanuatu.
- "Amber list" countries: Countries where active circulation of the virus is observed in controlled proportions, without spread of any variants of concern. These are all countries not included in the "green" and "red" list countries.
  - Countries subject to specific measures: The United Kingdom constitutes a special category of countries with active circulation of a variant, due to the specific measures applying to travel to and from this country since December 20, 2021.
- Countries where active circulation of the virus is observed with the presence of variants of concern. These include the following countries: Afghanistan, Belarus, Botswana,

  Democratic Republic of Congo, Eswatini, Georgia, Lesotho, Nigeria, Malawi, Mauritius, Moldavia,

  Montenegro, Mozambique, Namibia, Pakistan, Russia, South Africa, Suriname, Tanzania, Turkey,

  Ukraine, United States, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

COVID-19 Protocols and general information will be updated by March if any regulation evolves depending on the sanitary situation in France.
