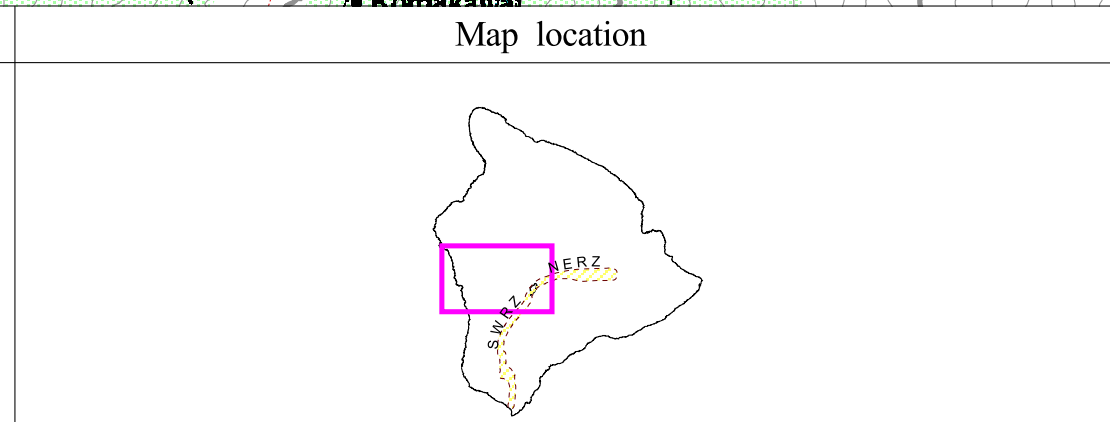

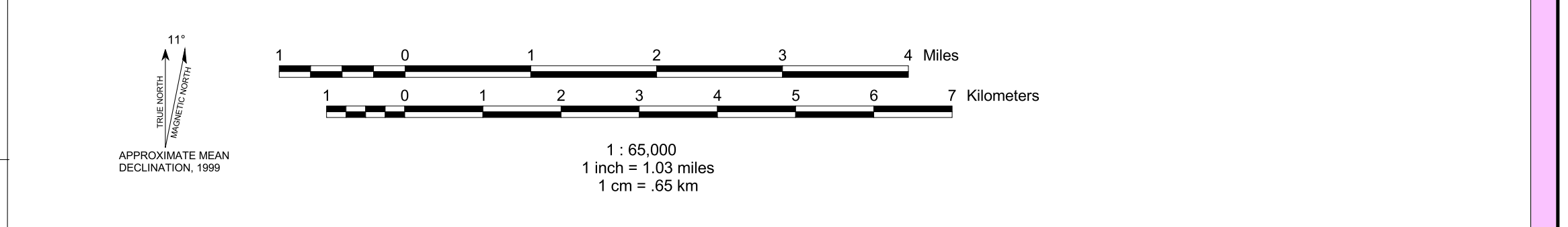
Map location
