



## KANGAROO FLATS TRAINING AREA, NORTHERN TERRITORY

### Description

Kangaroo Flats Training Area was established as a small arms firing range for use by NORFORCE in the late 1970s. The property has since been used for training activities including inert and live fire practice by the Army Reserve and the Australian Regular Army. The property is over 5,000 hectares in size, and is located approximately 30 kilometres south-east of Darwin.



### Base Activities

Activities include the use of firing ranges and the storage of diesel in above ground storage tanks near a generator facility.

### Contamination Information

#### Known Contamination

There are no known contamination issues at the property.

#### Risk Assessment

No significant risks to human health and the environment are identified on the base or on surrounding land based on investigations completed to date.

#### Current Status

Stage 1 desktop investigations have been completed for the property, including environmental investigation of ASTs/USTs.

Defence will conduct further investigations as required to assess the quality of soil and groundwater around the property.
