Property Description Sarria church, dedicated to the Madonna, was built in 1585 by the Knight Martino de Sarria Navarro, during the reign of Grand Master Verdala. In 1606 the Knight Giovanni Morizzi renovated it. After the plague of 1675 the Grand Master cottoner together with the Venerable council of the Order built in its place another church dedicated to the Immaculate Conception, in pursuance of a vow. It was designed by Mattia Preti, with Lorenzo Gafa as the engineer in charge of its construction. Each year a votive procession left St. John's Co-Cathedral and stopped at Sarria church where prayers of thanksgiving were recited. This procession is no longer held.
