Collegiate Summer leagues, semi-pro leagues, and all other non-professional leagues are excluded, but encouraged!

LEAGUE ASSOCIATIONS

The modern minor league system traces its roots to the formation of the National Association of Professional Baseball Leagues (NAPBL) in 1902, an umbrella organization that established league classifications and a salary structure in an agreement with Major League Baseball. The group simplified the name to “Minor League Baseball” in 1999.

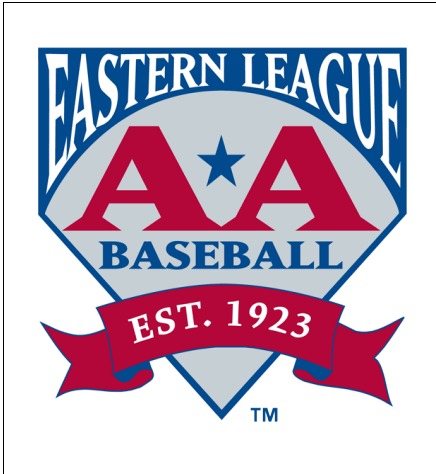

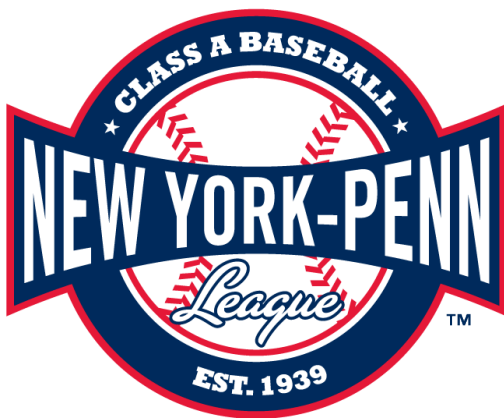

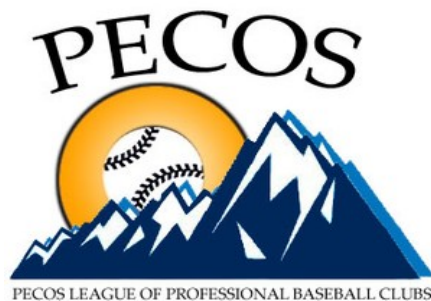
