

CHAPTER 1 Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Chapai Nawabganj is a district in northern Bangladesh. It is a part of the Rajshahi division. Originally it was a subdivision under Maldah (India) district. In 1947, this was severed from Maldah and was given to East Pakistan as a sub-division of Rajshahi district. Eventually, it became a separate district of Bangladesh in 1984. It is said that this area had strategic and commercial importance due to its location at the junction of the rivers Mahananda and the Ganges. Because of its importance, Nawab Alivardi founded Nawabganj town which in course of time known as Chapai Nawabganj.

Geographic Area and Location: Chapai Nawabganj district is bounded on the north by India, on the east by Naogaon and Rajshahi districts, on the south and west by India. The total area of the district is 1702.54 Sq.Km.(657.35 sq.miles). The district lies between 24°25′and 24°58′ north latitudes and between 88°01′ and 88°30′ east longitudes.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 37.8°C to minimum 11.2°C and annual average rainfall is 1862 mm.

Main Rivers: The Ganges, Mahananda, Pagla, Moraganga and Punarbhaba are the main rivers of this district.

Twonship: Chapai Nawabganj town has an area of 46.26 sq km. Chapai Nawabganj municipality was established in 1903. The town has two Dakbungalows, one Circuit house, one Officers' club, one BGB camp, one Mango research centre and one horticulture centre.

Administration: Until 1947, Nawabganj was a thana under the district of Maldah (India). At the time of partition, it was upgraded to a subdivision under Rajshahi district and again upgraded to a district in 1984. Chapai Nawabganj district consists of 5 upazilas, 45 unions, 785 mauzas, 1135 villages, 4 paurashavas, 42 wards and 156 mahallas. The upazilas are Bholahat, Gomastapur, Nachole, Chapainawabganj Sadar and Shibganj.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Chota Sona Mosque (1493-1519), Darashbari Mosque (1479), Rajbari (palace), Baragharia Kacharibari (revenue office), Chapai Mosque, Naoda Stupa (Buddhist monument), Jora Math (twin monastery), Nachole Palace, etc are notable archaeological heritage and relics.

Historical Events: Indigo Resistance Movement led by Dewanatullah Chowdhury in 1830-35 and Nachole Krishak Andolan (peasants' movement) organised by Ila Mitra in 1949 are memorable historical events of this district.

Marks of War of Liberation: Mass killing site: Nawabganj Shamshan (crematorium of Hindus), Rehaichar, Rohanpur Station Para, Satiar Bazaar (Bholahat) and Jadunagar (Bholahat) .Mass grave: near Sona Mosque, Shamsanghat, Boalia, Islampur and Gomostapur Fakirpara.Memorial monument: BGB compound, near Sona Mosque and premises of Chatrajitpur school & college are the marks of war of liberation.

Educational Institutions: The numbers of educational institutions are government college 6, private college 53, madrasa 224, government secondary school 4, private secondary school 184, junior high school 27, government primary school 370, private primary school 333, primary education training institute 2,technical and vocational training institute 13 and horticulture research and training centre 1.

Cultural Organisations: The numbers of cultural organizations are club 253, public library 7, cinema hall 3, theatre group 10, literary society 5, women's organisation 5, community centre 3, shilpakola academy 1 and auditorium 6.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, sugarcane, wheat, betel leaf, oil seeds, pulses are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Mango, jackfruit, litchi, black berry, palm, coconut, watermelon and boroi are main fruits of this district.

Manufacturing Industries: Silk mill, textile mill, cold storage and aluminium factory are different types of manufacturing industries of this dirtict.

Hats, Bazars and Fairs: The numbers of hats and bazars are 140 and fair are 25 in Chapai Nawabganj district.

NGO Activities: Operationally important NGOs are CARE, BRAC, ASA, Proshika, IDE, Dasco, Nijera Kari, Thengamara Mahila Sabuj Sangha (TMSS), Trinamul, Vision, Proyash, Manobic Unnayan Society, Swanirvar Artha-Samajik Unnayan Sangstha, Kolyani Mohila Sangsad, Amnura Santal Mission, BIKE, BISE, BIDOS, BARIO etc.

Economic Situation: The economy of Chapai Nawabganj district is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 320388 holdings of the district, 48.97% holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV paddy, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds, and other minor crops. Various fruits like mango, banana, jackfruits, guava, coconut etc. are grown. The district holds a special position in terms of growing mango which is an important cash crop of this district. Large quantity of mangoes of big size is grown in the district and the farmers earn huge amount of money by selling this delicious fruit. Varieties of fish are caught from rivers, flowing channels and even paddy fields during rainy seasons. Besides crops, livestock and fishery are the main sources of household income.

Non-agricultural activities are still sparse and an impression about their extent can be obtained from the following table 1 based on the 2001 & 2003 Census of non-farm economic activities.

Flora and Fauna

Flora

Mammals: In most of the upazilas of the Chapai Nawabganj district, the relief is that of broad flood plain ridges and basins with broad high ridges along the Mahananda and pagla rivers. Basins and lawer ridges have clays, with loams on the higher ridges. A small part of Bholahat, the eastern part of Gomastapur and part of Chapai Nawabganj upazilas of the district lie in the Barind Tiact belonging to an older alluvion formation. The southern part of the district lies in the active Ganges flood plain along the left bank of the Ganges. This is an area of chars and Diaras the soils of which are mixed sands and silts, with some friable clay in depressions. The district contains a few beels.

The croppig pattern of the district is largely similar to that of adjoining districts. Various agricultural crops are grown in this district. Among rice crops, aman covers the largest area followed by aus and boro (Agricultural Census 2008). Mango is the major cash crop. Wheat cultivation is spreading. Mulberry for rearing silkworms is grown on raised plots. Rabi crops include mash, mustard, barley, gram, masur, khesari, motor, sesame, onion and garlic, maize and potato, vegetables are also grown here. Along with mango there are also orchards of jackfruit, lichi, guava and other fruits. Bamboo is also grown.

The village homesteads are usually masked by assorted tree species, shrubs and thickets of bamboos. Common trees found in other parts of Bangladesh like black-barry (*Syzygium* cumini), jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), neem tree (*Azadirachta indica*), simul tree (*Bombax ceiba*), bastard teak (Butea monosperma), wood apple (*Aegle marmelos*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), betelnut (Areca catechu), guava (Psidium guajava), plum (Ziziphus virgata), Katbadam (Terminalia catappa), tamarind (Tamarindus indica), banian tree (*Ficus benghalensis*), peepul tree (*Ficus religlosa*), arjun (*Terminalia arjuna*), bhadi (*Lannea coromandelica*), sajna (Moringa obifera) etc. are also found in this area. Trees that are widely grown in this area are khair (Acacia catechu), palm tree (*Borassus flabellifer*), babla/acacia (*Acacia nilotica*), siris (*Abizzia lebbeck*), bilati siris (*Samanea saman*), shet khoiyer (*Acacia suma*), chakua koroi (Albizia chinensis) etc.

Besides, the floating vegetation that are commonly seen in the homestead ponds are kachuri pana (Telanphera philoxroides), khudi pana (*Lemna paucicos tata*), topa pana (*Pisitias tratiotes lemna spirodela*), the floating ferns like azolla pinnata, salvisnia cucullata etc. Moreover, some water plants like water lily (Nymphaea nochali), lotus (Nelumbo nucifera), kalmi (Polygonum), helencha (Tilanthera philoxcroides) etc. are also seen in the shallow water of ponds, ditches and beels of the area.

In addition some ornamental plants are grown at the homesteads for aesthetic purposes. These are shefaly, beli, kamini, jaba, chaina-box, china-rose, yellow oleander, dolon champa, patabahar, night queen etc.

Fauna: The wild fauna that are usually seen in the Chapai Nawabganj district which are largely similar to those of the adjoining districts. The mammals of the district comprise jackal (Canis aureus), banbiral (Felis chaus), bara benji (Herpestes edwardsi), rat (Bandicota bengalensis), metho mouse (Mus booduga), nengti mouse (Mus musculus), common house rat (Rathus rattus), monkey (Macaca mullata), bat (Pteropus giganteus), tiskell's bat (Hesperoptenus tickelli) etc.

Birds: Fauna of an area consists of both the resident and the migrant birds. Among the resident birds, few are common in the rural as well as urban areas. These are crow (Corvus splendens),

sparrow (Passer domesticus), martin (Acridotheres tristis), redvented bulbul (Picnonotus cafer) and the pariah Kite (Migyans lineatas), other common birds include magpie (Copsychus saularis), tuntuni (Orthotomus sutorius), swallow (Ploceus philippinus), raven (Corvus macrorhynchos), kingfisher (Alcedo atthis), woodpaker (Picus myrmecophoneus), choto fingey (Dicrurus macrocercus), Kali pencha (Glaucidium radiatum), lakkhi pencha (Tyto alba), haldey pakhi (Oriolus xanthornvscus), koel (Endynamus scolopacea), choto harial (Treron phoenicoptera), botkol (Treron phoenicoptera), dhumkol (Ducula badia), tilaghughu (Streptopelia chinensis), parakeet (Psittacula cupatria), waterhen (Amaurornis phoenicurus), red kite (Haliaster Indus), big white heron (Ardea alba), kana korchy heron (Ardeola grayii), diver (Phalacrocot niger), tila munia (Lonchura punctulataloch) etc.

Reptiles and Amphibians: Of the Chelonia, kali kaitta (*Hardella thurjii*), kori kaitta (*kachuga tecta*) and dhum tortoise (*Trionyx hurum*) are found in this area. Of the Squamata, lizard (Hemid sctylus brooki) is definitely the most common and best known. Other common species are lizard (Hemidactylus brooki), shanda (*Gekko gecko*), of varanidae family, iguana (*Varanus bengalensis*) and hungui shap (*Varanus flavescens*) are also seen in the area. Some poisonous snakes like Jait shap (*Naja kaouthia*), shankhini shap (*Bungarus cacruleus*) and kal keotey shap (*Bungarus fasciatus*) are infrequently met with. The non-poisonous snakes include dhora shap (*Xenoclrophis piscator*), paina shap (*Enhydris enhydris*), daraj shap (*Ptyas mucous*) etc.

Among the amphibians the most common species are kotkoti frog (*Rana cyanophlyctis*), Bhawa frog (*Rana tigerina*), and Jhijhi frog (*Rana limnocharis*).

Fishes: The most popular varieties of fresh water fish that are available in this district are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), catla (*Catla catla*), mrigel (*Cirrhinusa mrigala*) and Kalibaush (*Labeo calbasu*). Other varieties of fish include airh (*Mystus aor*), chital (*Notopterus chitala*), pangas (*Pangas ius pangasius*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), sarpunti (*Barbus sarana*) etc. Morever, a few exotic varieties of fish are also available here.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza**: Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) Village: Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) Mahalla: Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

- i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.
- **ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). The year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large**: Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

Intensity of cropping =
$$\frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
