The Primary Election decides which candidates will represent each political party in the November General Election. In September, watch for an updated edition of this *Voter Guide* for the General Election.

Neither. It is factual, impartial, and nonpartisan. Every candidate in the covered races was treated equally and had the same opportunity to respond to the questions.

- 14. Taxpayer dollars subsidizing paid time off for public employees to engage in union activities.
- 15. Protecting individuals and businesses from being required to provide services or use their artistic expression in a manner that violates their moral or religious beliefs.


