CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Stratford-on-Avon (Parishes) Order 1988

Made 25th January 1988

Coming into force-

for the purposes referred

to in article 1(2) 31st January 1988

for all other purposes 1st April 1988

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect with modifications to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) of that Act by the Stratford-on-Avon District Council for proposals about parishes in the district:

Citation and commencement

1.-(1) This Order may be cited as the Stratford-on-Avon (Parishes) Order 1988.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 31st January 1988 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (b).

(2) The parishes and the parish authorities of the parishes named in column 2 of the above table shall cease to exist. The residuary successor of each authority of an abolished parish shall be the authority of the relevant new parish named in column 1, which shall also have custody of the public books and documents of that abolished parish.

(3) The proper officer of the Stratford-on-Avon District Council shall convene the first assembly of the parish meeting of each new parish.

Transfers between parishes

4.-(1) The areas marked on the boundary map as shown in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order shall be transferred from the relevant parish named in column 3 to that named in column 4.

(2) Where in column 5 there is mentioned in relation to any area -

- (a) a parish ward;
- (b) a district ward;
- (c) a county electoral division; or
- (d) a petty sessional division-

that area shall in addition be transferred to that ward or division.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order affects parishes in the district of Stratford-on-Avon. It -

- (a) creates 3 new parishes: Hodnell and Wills Pastures, Radbourn, and Upper and Lower Shuckburgh;
- (b) transfers areas between parishes; and
- (c) abolishes the parishes of Hodnell, Lower Radbourn, Lower Shuckburgh, Upper Radbourn, Upper Shuckburgh, and Wills Pastures.

Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.

The maps forming part of this note (pages 7 and 8) give a general guide to the areas affected. Prints of the detailed boundary map (described in article 2) may be inspected at all reasonable times at the office of the Stratford-on-Avon District Council and at the office of the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

The new parishes will have approximately the area, population and rateable value shown below-
