
STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

HOW DO I APPLY?

Students apply to MTC January 3-March 31, 2017

Step 1: Complete the MTC Application online at <u>www.lcps.org/mtc</u>; Step 2: Work with your counselor to find a schedule that works for you and allows you to attend MTC on either A or B Days; Step 3: If applying to a dual enrolled program, apply online to Northern Virginia Community College (NVCC) <u>www.nvcc.edu</u> Step 4: Provide evidence of college readiness in Math and English through existing test scores (i.e. PSAT, SAT, SOL, and VPT scores) or arrange to take the Math or English Virginia Placement test through NVCC.

Step 5: Your application is reviewed by a selection committee and you will be notified of your application status in mid-May.
