# Do you support or oppose legislation that prohibits sex education from being taught in schools from kindergarten to third grade?



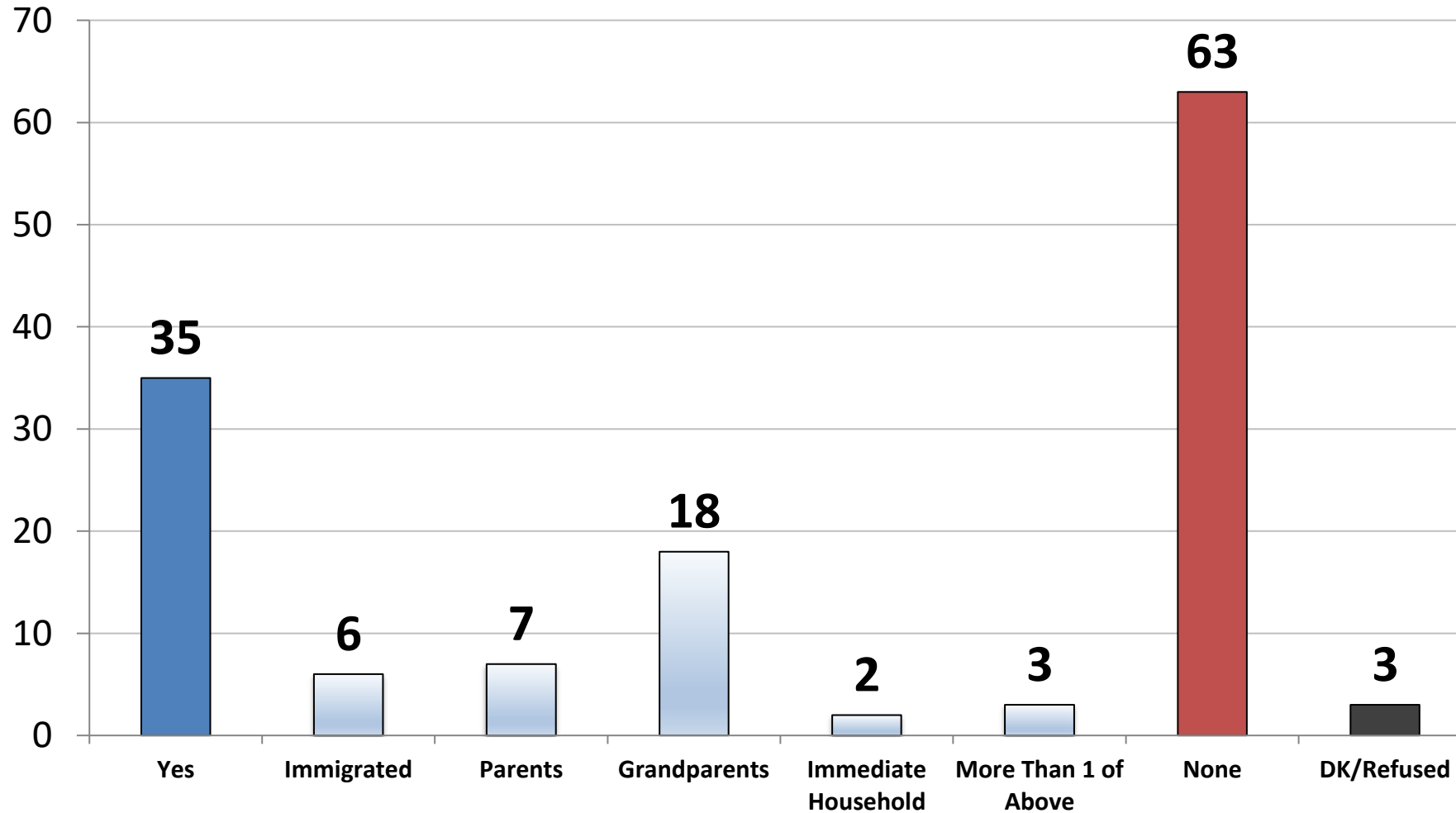
