
BEACHES TORPEDOED SHIP.

**Captain Runs the Tunisiana Ashore
with Cargo of Wheat.**

LONDON, June 23.—The steamer Tunisiana has been torpedoed of Lowestoft by a German submarine. Her skipper was able to beach her.

The Tunisiana was bound from Montreal to Hull with 5,000 tons of wheat. Her crew landed at Lowestoft.

The British steamer Tunisiana is of 4,220 tons gross and is 360 feet long. She was built in 1906 at Newcastle.
