National governments in Europe do their best to cause problems for commercial radios - that's the conclusion of one of the organisers of MIDEM's three-day radio seminar. With the controversial views of Margot Gardett steering the way, the radio discussions are obviously going to have quite a bite next year.

* * * Was Frans De Wit a little too optimistic last week in suggesting an announcement was "imminent" in connection with the purchase of SBK Songs? The MD of EMI Music now says things are "taking longer than anticipated".

* * * Rumours are flying around Paris that Jerome Clement, President of the prestigious French National Cinematographic Centre, is high on the list of candidates to take over from Claude Contamine, President of state TV channel Antenne 2. Clement, it is said, has the experience and political neutrality. which Contamine lacks. It is unlikely, though, that any decision will be made before the new CSA regulatory body is fully in place * * *

The latest figures on worldwide sales of records and tapes show a 16.7% increase in 1986 compared to 1985. Total sales in 1986 were worth USS 14 billion for over 2.3 billion units. The US retains around 33% of the global market, Japan is next with 14%, West Germany is third with 9%, and the UK follows with 8%. The figures are contained in the recently published year-book of the British Phonographic Industry.

* * * The Super Channel story goes on with reports this week that Virgin, which owns almost half of the satellite service, is owed £ 2.6 million by the company and not the "nearly £ 6 million" previously quoted by Maria Lina Marcucci. * * *

The UK satellite venture BSB has just announced its largest deal to date with the purchase of rights to screen 175 feature films owned by Colombia Pictures. BSB will pay over US\$ 60 million for the films. The company has refused to say how the deal will be financed but recently announced a £ 75 million increase in its launch budget.

Back in France, there are rumours that Marie-France Briere, Head Of Light entertainment at La Cinq, may soon join RMC as Programme Director.



The one-hour special, produced by Tyne Tees Television. shows footage from a concert held in Barcelona on October 8 as part of the programme leading up to the Summer Olympics to be held there in 1992. Directed by Gavin Taylor, the concert closes with Freddie Mercury and Monserrat Caballe performing Barcelong to the 150,000 strong crowd. It will be screened on Boxing Day at midnight.

The offshoot of all this activity is that independents are now springing up all over the country. In towns and cities from Seville to Bilbao, where there simply were not any labels, what happened in Barcelona is being repeated.

In an attempt to capitalise on this, Teddysound is organising a Spanish delegation for the next MIDEM conference in Cannes, Alfonso says: "We hope all these labels will stick together so that we can compete with the majors. Together we have a lot of muscle and

BOY MEETS GIRL



After spending years in the wilderness, with little or no home-grown talent and a backward music industry, there is new life in Spain's entertainment sector. Much of the energy is coming from indie companies that have been set up by entrepreneurs who have worked for the major labels.

A good example of this new energy is in the publishing sector. Teddysound is based in Barcelona and was formed when ex-musician Joaquin Alfonso bought an old publishing house. At that time the company owned 800 copyrights, all of them traditional Spanish music. Since then Teddysound has added 100 more Spanish titles and, more significantly, 300 foreign copyrights.

These include quite a few Italian artists like Den Harrow, the Full Time catalogue, the latest LP from US soul/jazz singer and saxophone player Rosa King, Sempre Sempre by Al Bano and Romina Power, and we should use it."



Until then, the Dutch record buying public had been starved of the latest developments in pop and rock. Jacobs says demand easily exceeded supply: "There used to be one weekly consignment of imports arriving at Schipbel airport every Saturday morning. People used to be queueing outside the shop when lieft to pick up the records."

Boudisqué hit the news headlines: in 1970 when it released three bootleg LPs (two by Bob Dylan and one by the Rolling Stones) on its own Hobo label which was set up especially for the occasion." We really did not know it was illegal," suys Jacobs. "We were very naive and actually made inquiries about paying mechanical royatics. The albums sold really well and we got a lot of publicity."





Looking back over the last 20 years, Jacobs says: "In the beginning we were looked down on by the rest of the business in Holland. But slowly and surely, the major record companies realised they could not afford to do without us. We are now seen as a positive force in the industry."


