

## Triangle/Short Row Scarf (F121) Using Cascade Di.Ve Teseo Pattern



Triangle/Short Row Scarf (F121) Designed by Sheila Johnson

Materials:

**3 skeins of Teseo** 1 pair of US size 10 needles.

Terms:

**CO-cast on** st-stitch sts-stithes Inc-increase into front and back of stitch SKP-slip first stitch, K1, pass slip stitch over knitted stitch

Instructions:

CO1st. Row 1: Inc into st. You will have 2 sts Row 2: Inc into first st, knit remaining sts. You will have 3 sts.

Repeat Row 2 increasing into the first stitch and knitting the remaining stitches until piece measures approximately 5". Do not measure the open (live) stitches; measure from the cast on stitch down one side of the triangle. Once it is the size you want you can start your short row sections.

Short-row section:

Row 1: Inc into first st, SKP. Turn your work Row 2 :Knit Row 3: Inc into first st, K1, SKP. Turn your work Row 4: Knit Row 5: Inc into first st, K2, SKP. Turn your work. Row 6: Knit Row 7: Inc into first st, K3, SKP. Turn your work

Continue adding one stitch before each SKP in odd numbered rows and knit all even rows. Work this pattern until you have SKP the last stitch in the row; now you will start the short row section over again. Do the short row section until you have the scarf the length that you want.

Last triangle:

Decrease: SKP, K to end
