As my parents had lost Indian citizenship prior to my birth, they could not have transmitted Indian citizenship to me. In any event, India does not allow dual citizenship. I have never taken any steps to acquire Indian citizenship or Overse

citizenship. I have never taken any steps to acquire Indian citizenship or Overseas Citizenship of India. Even if my parents were Portuguese citizens when I was born, which they were not, under Portuguese citizenship law I would not have acquired Portuguese citizenship automatically and I have never applied for it.
