The Allen County Coroner's Office was notified of the shooting investigation in the 200 block of East Sherwood Terrace, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46806, at about 0400 hours on November 9, 2017. The Allen County Coroner's Office has completed the autopsies and notification has been made to the next of kin of the two deceased individuals from this shooting investigation.

Nicole Marie Saylor, female white 36 years of age, from Fort Wayne, Indiana was found suffering from gunshot wound(s) at the scene. Nicole Marie Saylor was pronounced deceased at the scene. The Cause of Death has been determined to be Gunshot Wound(s) and the Manner of Death is Homicide. Nicole Marie Saylor is the 32nd homicide in Allen County in 2017.

Kayla Marie Harris, female white 24 years of age, from Fort Wayne, Indiana was found suffering from gunshot wound(s) at the scene and was transported to a local hospital where death was pronounced a short time after arrival. The Cause of Death has been determined to be Gunshot Wound(s) and the Manner of Death is Homicide. Kayla Marie Harris is the 33rd homicide in Allen County in 2017.

This incident remains under investigation by the Fort Wayne Police Department, the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney's Office and the Allen County Coroner's Office.
