CGF Sport Update

1. B2022 Event Viability Update

In line with the CGF Event Viability Policy, the CGF Sports Committee has been continuing to track the viability of events on the B2022 medal event programme throughout the Team Size Calculator process. This has enabled the Sports Committee to identify where estimated entry levels are tracking as undersubscribed and for the necessary interventions to be made, including the strategic distribution of contingency slots to support such events.

The list of events that are currently tracking as undersubscribed (as of May 2022) is attached at Appendix 1.

CGAs are reminded that the CGF Sports Committee has approved that there will be no further removal of events from the B2022 medal event programme however, where entries fall below a certain threshold following the Entry by Name deadline, the CGF Medal Allocation Policy will be applied. Therefore, it is requested that CGAs entered in these events (displayed in Appendix 1) continue to support these events in their TSC4/Final Entry by Name submissions to ensure their viability for B2022.

2. Distribution of Contingency Slots – Distribution 4b

In accordance with the published criteria for Distribution 4b, the CGF Sports Committee approved the distribution of a total of total of 44 slots (23 Men and 21 Women) to 15 CGAs across 3 regions in 12 sports/disciplines.

The deadline for CGAs to confirm acceptance of their contingency slots under Distribution 4b is no later than 23:59 (GMT+1) on 27 May 2022.



3. Distribution of Contingency Slots – Distribution 5

As outlined in the Distribution of Contingency Slots Policy version 3 (February 2022), CGAs that wish to be considered for Contingency Slots are required to register their interest by completing and returning the EOI Form. CGAs are also reminded that in order to be considered for Contingency Slots they must submit Team Size Calculator (TSC) information to the B2022 Organising Committee by the deadlines published.

This will be the final round of Distribution for B2022 and is subject to availability of contingency slots, although it is anticipated there will be limited contingency slots available at this stage.

Please note that Contingency Slots will only be distributed in Open Athlete Allocation Quota sports.

The CGF Sports Committee has agreed that all criteria outlined in the Distribution of Contingency Slots Policy as listed below in no particular order will be considered for Distribution 5, and expressions of interest assessed accordingly:

1. Support Host CGA participation (quality)
2. Support undersubscribed events (quantity) - *a list of events that are currently tracking as undersubscribed is attached at Appendix 1.*
3. Support the participation of top Commonwealth athletes on a sport specific basis, not otherwise selected (quality)
4. Ensure gender representation on a sport specific basis (universality)
5. Ensure regional representation on a sport specific basis (universality)
6. Support athlete performance pathways for athletes on an identifiable development pathway not otherwise selected, on a sport specific basis (universality)
7. Support small CGA participation (universality)
8. Next Host CGA team development priorities (quality)

We strongly encourage that CGAs prioritise applications for athletes that are listed on their B2022 accreditation long lists and that as much detail as possible is provided in the EOI form, outlining the use of the requested slots (sport/event/gender/athlete/performance history).

CGAs are required to complete and submit the EOI Form 5 by no later than 23:59 (GMT+1) on 01 June 2022 to the B2022 Sport Entries Manager Gabriel Pontes at gabriel.pontes@birmingham2022.com. CGAs will be notified of the outcome of Distribution 5 at the earliest opportunity and by no later than 01 July 2022.

5. CGF Sport Policies – B2022

CGAs are kindly reminded to review and familiarise themselves with the below CGF Sport Policies for the B2022 Games:

- **Event Viability Policy – Issued Oct 2021**
 - Outlines the criteria and considerations to determine if an event is categorised as undersubscribed
 - Note: Following a review of TSC3 data, the CGF Sports Committee has approved that from this point forward there will be no further removal of events from the B2022 medal event programme. Where entries fall below a certain threshold following the Entry by Name deadline, the CGF Medal Allocation Policy will be applied
- **Medal Allocation Policy – issued Jan 2022**
 - Outlines the medal allocation where entries fall below a certain threshold:
 - 5 or more contestants: Gold, Silver and Bronze
 - 4 contestants: Gold and Silver only
 - 3 or 2 contestants: Gold only
- **Late Entries – Issued Oct 2021**
 - Outlines that No late entries will be accepted after the B2022 Entry by Name deadline as at 23:59 (GMT + 1) on 29 June 2022.



- **Withdrawal Policy – Issued Oct 2021**
 - Outlines the principles and process in relation to the withdrawal of athletes from B2022 following the Entry by Name Deadline (29 June 2022) to support the distribution or reallocation to other CGAs to ensure the full usage of athlete slots.
- **Late Athlete Replacement Policy – Issued Jan 2022**
 - Outlines the principles, criteria, and process in relation to the consideration of like for like athlete replacements at B2022 under extenuating/extraordinary circumstances. Please note that changes may need to be made to the LAR Policy to account for the Covid protocols for B2022. Any update will be issued to CGAs as soon as possible.
