
WRIGHT FLIES IN ITALY.

**Takes Up Italian Army Officer in His
Aeroplane and Later Signor Sonnino.**

ROME, April 16.—Wilbur Wright, the American aeroplanist, made three successful flights in his flying machine near here this morning. He remained in the air ten, eight, and seven minutes respectively and was accompanied each time by an Italian army officer. A great crowd saw the exhibition.

Mr. Wright made two further flights during the afternoon, taking former Premier Sonnino with him as a passenger.
