2018 will be the last year that we will be using the Six Lane program in West Michigan. Please continue this program until the end of 2018 for your church's mission planning and programing. Starting on January 1, 2019 we will be starting with a new mission program called ENGAGE. This new program combines West Michigan Conference's 6-Lanes and Detroit Conference's Spotlight Church. The whole state of Michigan has a big heart for mission here and around the world and by joining our conference's mission programs we will be living into the calling that God has set before us.

Important note ...

This booklet replaces all prior editions of the *Six Lanes of the Advance*. The General Board of Global Ministries has discontinued many projects and has changed the numbers for others. To assure that your dollars go to active ministries, it is important to use the projects and numbers listed in this 2018edition. (Or consult the comprehensive book published by the General Board.)

Driving the 1st and 2nd Miles of Mission

United Methodists support mission outreach in a variety of ways. The primary route is through apportioned giving. An apportionment invites each congregation to remit a "fair share" of dollars to connectional ministry and mission. In West Michigan apportionments are called "Ministry Shares." Ministry Shares are considered First Mile Giving. Churches should pay Ministry Shares in full before they begin to designate other giving.

Ministry Shares fund World Service and Conference Benevolences. World Service is the heart of our United Methodist presence world-wide. World Service dollars: provide support for over 9,000 mission projects around the world and across the U.S.; provide a network of missionaries, developers, and chaplains; fund schools and colleges; make a wide variety of resources available to local churches and much more. Conference Benevolences stay in West Michigan, maintaining camps, youth ministries, community centers, campus outreach, training for pastors and laypersons, and much more.

John Wesley once said, "Do all the good you can, in all the places you can, to all the people you can." In the spirit of John Wesley, churches that pay their First Mile giving then go on to Second Mile giving through The Advance. The Advance is a way to support projects with special interest to a congregation. An important feature of The Advance is that 100% of every donation goes to the chosen project. This is a claim no other charitable organization can make. Since 1948 The Advance has channeled \$1.2 billion to thousands of ministries in 125 countries.

The West Michigan Conference organizes "The Advance" in Six Lanes:

- Lane 1: Missionary Salary Support
- Lane 2: Global Projects
- Lane 3: National Projects
- Lane 4: UMCOR/Hunger Relief
- Lane 5: Racial Ethnic Local Churches
- Lane 6: Conference Projects

The Six Lanes is simply a model to help achieve a broad scope of outreach that touches neighbors next door as well as neighbors in places far away. Cruise these pages. Cruise, choose from the dozens of projects, and plan to be a Six Lanes Church.
