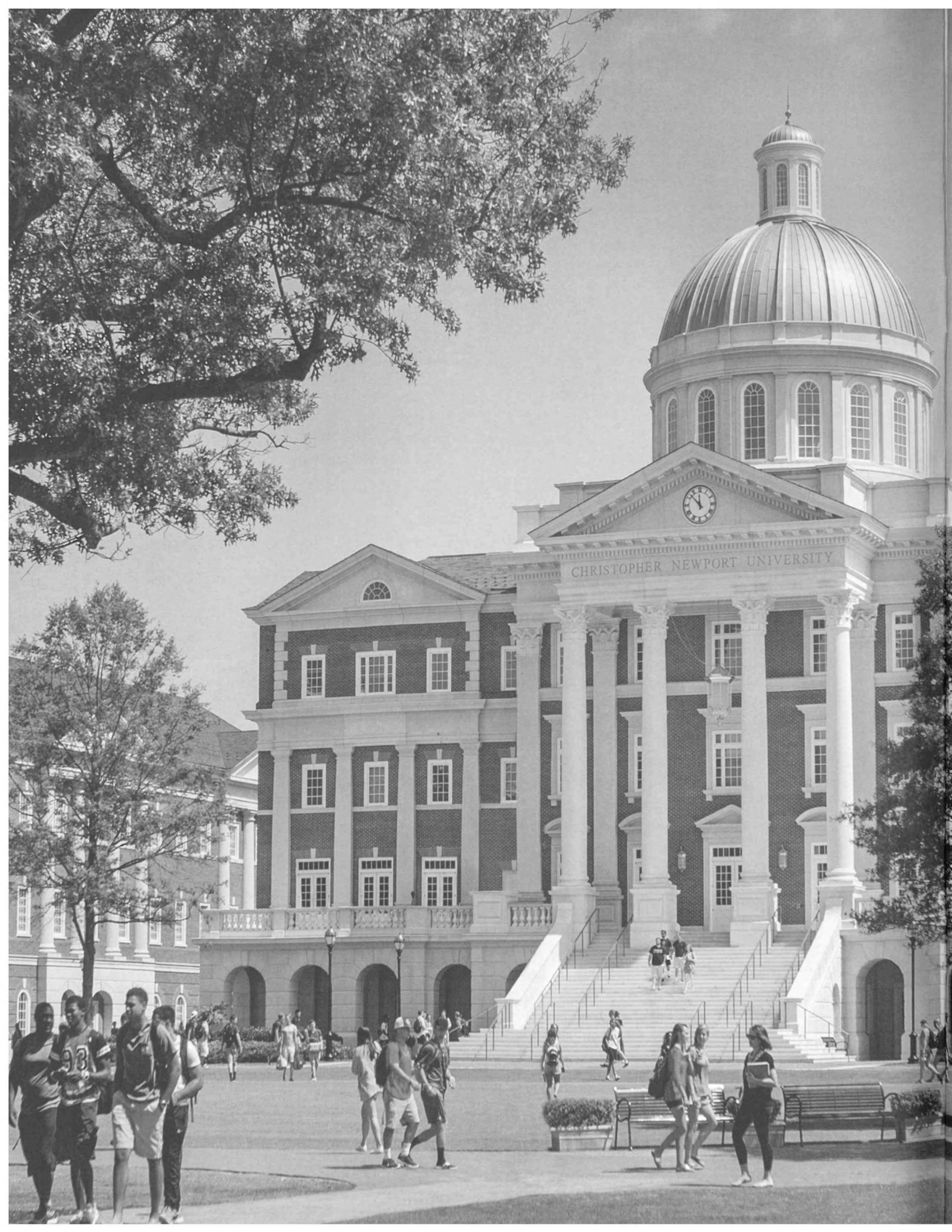

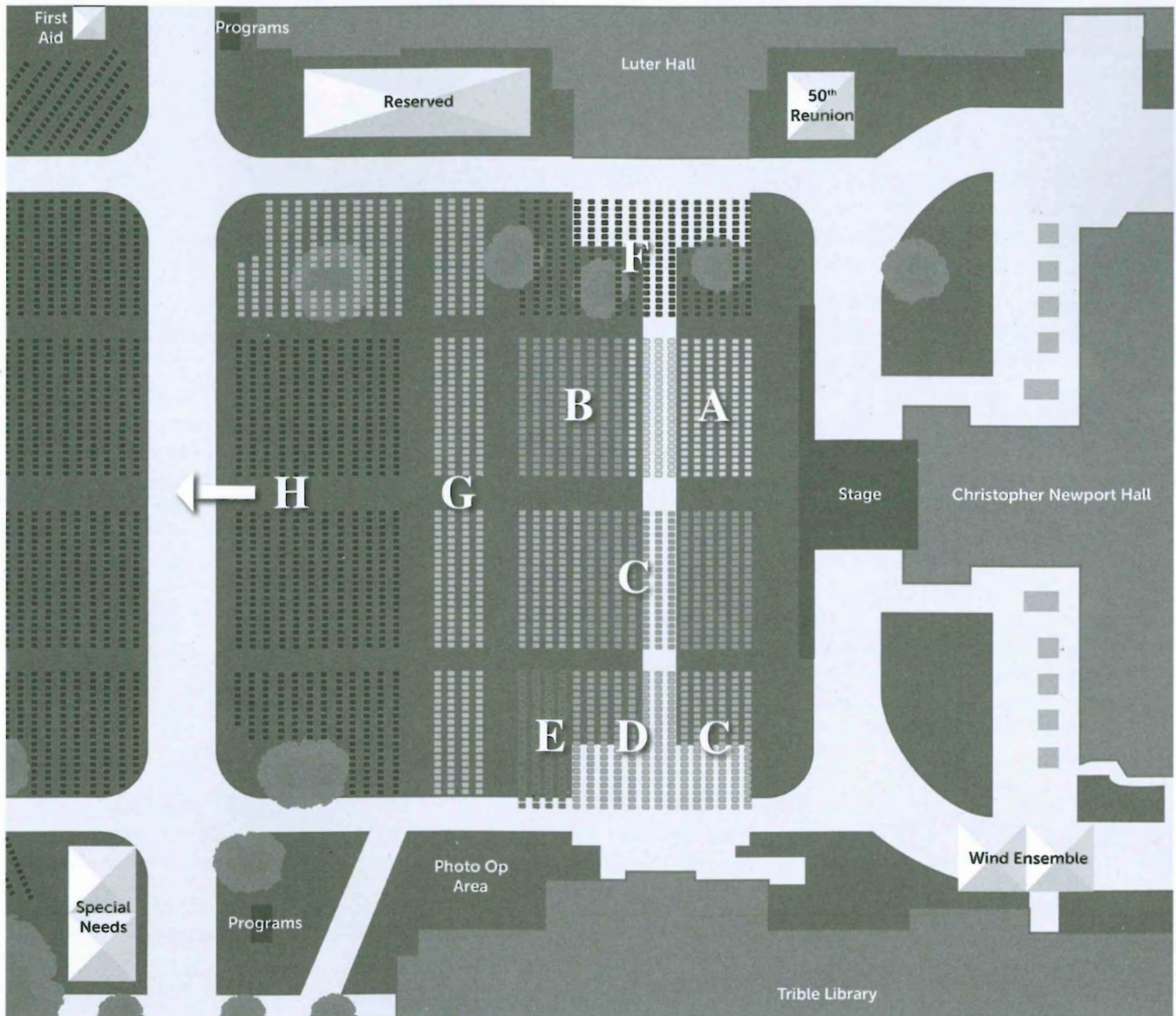

# ACADEMIC REGALIA

The wearing of caps, gowns and hoods at college and university occasions dates back to the formation of universities in Europe, beginning around the 12th century. The ordinary dress of the scholar, whether student or teacher, was the dress of clerics. Historians suggest that gowns and hoods were the simplest and most effective method of staying warm in the unheated, stone buildings that housed medieval scholars. The gowns used in American academic ceremonies vary according to the highest degree awarded to the wearer.

## The Degree Candidates

### Bachelor's Degrees

Candidates for the bachelor's degree wear a gown that falls to the knee, has a closed front and long, pointed, open sleeves. Candidates wear black mortarboard caps with black tassels. All candidates for first degrees wear the tassel on the right side of the cap until the degree has been conferred.

### Master's Degrees

Candidates for master's degrees wear a gown with a closed front with oblong sleeves, open at the wrist. Candidates wear black mortarboard caps with black tassels.

## The Hood

The hoods are lined in silk with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree. More than one color is shown by division of the field color in a variety of ways, such as by chevrons. Christopher Newport University graduates wear a hood lined in blue with a silver chevron. The binding or edging of the hood is in velvet with widths of two inches for the bachelor's degree and three inches for the master's degree. The color of the border signifies the degree granted by Christopher Newport University:

## The Faculty

Faculty members wear regalia that represent their disciplines and the institution of higher learning that granted their degrees. The doctor's gown has an open front and large bell-shaped sleeves with three velvet bars (black, but sometimes in discipline colors). Doctor's caps may be made of velvet and may have tassels of gold or the wearer's degree. Hood linings, edges and chevrons represent the field in which the degree was granted:

## COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

### SUZANNE SCHEUBLE



Suzanne Scheuble is the founder of a home for abandoned and orphaned children in Ethiopia and the daughter of Christopher Newport alumnus Dan Scheuble ('81).

Scheuble was inspired by a visit to Ethiopia as a teenager where she witnessed abandoned babies, people dying of AIDS, and children suffering from starvation and tuberculosis. After earning a bachelor's degree in child psychology at the University of North Florida, she consulted with pediatricians and child psychologists and raised funds to develop the first specialized care homes for children in Ethiopia. Lantu's Home of Hidden Treasures is a family-style facility providing individualized care and attention for children with special needs.

The Home's mission is to "create beautiful places of love and joy for special needs orphans and abandoned children in Ethiopia to grow, heal and be treasured." Suzanne lives with her husband, Dr. Abrham Kumlachew, and their 1-year-old adopted daughter across the street from her two childrens homes. She supervises a staff of 43 and serves 40 abandoned and neglected children.
