# ReVerb Climbing Wall Hat

## Size:

Teen / Adult Small  
(Adult Medium,  
Adult Large)

## Finished Measurements:

About 16 1/2 (18,  
19 1/2)" brim  
circumference  
(unstretched)  
and 9 1/2" tall.  
Sample hat is size  
Adult Medium

## Materials:

- Cascade Yarns®  
ReVerb  
70% Polyester (recycled  
PET /  
30% Alpaca (recycled)
- 100 g (3.5 oz) /  
273 yds (250 m)
- 1 skein of color  
#3 (Olive)
- US 3 (3.25 mm) 16"  
circular needle
- US 5 (3.75 mm) 16"  
circular needle or size  
to obtain gauge and  
set of double pointed  
needles (DPN)
- Spare circular needle  
size US 3 (3.25 mm)  
or smaller
- Waste yarn for  
provisional cast on
- Marker (m)
- Yarn needle



ReVerb

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25 sts x 44 rounds= 4" in Pattern Stitch on larger needles after blocking.

**Abbreviations:**

CO	= Cast On
K	= Knit
P	= Purl
Rnd	= Round
Sl	= Slip one st purlwise with yarn in back
St(s)	= Stitch(es)
K2tog	= Knit 2 stitches together (1 st decreased)
P2tog	= Purl 2 stitches together (1 st decreased)
SSK	= Slip two sts one at a time as to knit, insert tip of left needle into slipped sts and knit them together thru back loops (1 st decreased)

**Special Stitches:****K1, P1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts):**

Rnd 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Repeat Rnd 1 for pattern.

**Note:**

Spare needle is only used to hold CO sts when joining doubled brim.

Be sure to slip all stitches with yarn in back. On rounds 3 and 7, you will move the yarn from the front (purl position) to the back before slipping the stitch.

**Hat:**

With smaller needle and using a provisional cast on, CO 124 (136, 148) sts. Place marker (m) and join to knit in the round. Work in K1, P1 Rib until brim measures 4".

Carefully place 124 (136, 148) cast on sts on a spare circular needle and remove waste yarn. Fold brim to the inside, wrong sides together, so that needle with CO sts is behind working needle. Joining rnd: \*Knit 1 st from front (working) needle tog with 1 st from back (spare) needle; rep from \* to end – 124 (136, 148) sts.

**Change to larger needle and begin pattern stitch:**

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: \*Knit 3, sl 1, rep from \* to end of rnd.

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Rnd 3: \*Purl 3, sl 1, rep from \* to end of rnd.  
 Rnd 4 and 5: Knit.  
 Rnd 6: \*Knit 1, sl 1, k2, rep from \* to end of rnd.  
 Rnd 7: \*Purl 1, sl 1, p2, rep from \* to end of rnd.  
 Rnd 8: Knit.

Repeat 8 rounds of pattern st until hat measures about 7" from fold at bottom of brim ending with a completed Rnd 8.

**Decrease for crown (change to DPN when necessary):**

Rnd 1: Knit  
 Rnd 2: \*Knit 2 tog, k1, sl 1, rep from \* to end of rnd – 93 (102, 111) sts  
 Rnd 3: \*Purl 2, sl 1, rep from \* to end of rnd  
 Rnd 4 and 5: Knit  
 Rnd 6: \*Sl 1, k2tog, rep from \* to end of rnd – 62 (68, 74) sts  
 Rnd 7: \*Sl 1, p1, rep from \* to end of rnd  
 Rnd 8 and 9: Knit  
 Rnd 10: \*Ssk, k2tog, rep from \* to end of rnd – 31 (34, 37) sts  
 Rnd 11: \*K2tog, p2tog, rep from \* to last 1 (2, 3) sts; knit 1 (2, 3) – 16 (18, 20) sts  
 Rnd 12: K2tog around – 8 (9, 10) sts

Break yarn, leaving a 6" tail. With tail threaded on tapestry needle, draw tail through 8 (9, 10) remaining sts and pull to close. Fasten off on wrong side. Weave in all tails and block as desired.
