# STATISTICAL REPORT

## of Seventh-day Adventist Conferences, Missions, and Institutions in World Field

For the Year Ending December 31, 1945

With transportation and communication facilities still much below normal, some divisions of the General Conference world field have not been able to make complete reports of their activities and standing for the year 1945. Without doubt, if full reports had come from all sections, the notations of church memberships, tithe and mission receipts, and other data would show more favorably than are here recorded. The Lord's hand is over His work, which is the assurance of progress.

The latest reports of Seventh-day Adventist church memberships from the several divisions of the General Conference compared with previous years are shown below. Current reports to the end of 1945 are given for Australasia, China, Inter-America, North America, South America, and South Africa, and Southern Asia; other divisions are from the latest available returns except the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics which is estimated.

**FOOTNOTES—TABLE 2, SECTION 1, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS**

(a) The system of educational work outlined by the Educational Department of the General Conference in 1906, comprising sixteen grades or years of study, is arranged as follows: Elementary church schools (information concerning which will be found listed under columns 24 to 28 in Table 1), grades 1-8; intermediate schools, grades 7-10; academies or secondary schools, grades 9-12; colleges, grades 13-16. In schools outside of North America this classification of grades cannot be fully followed owing to differences in educational systems and because training standards are not uniform in all localities.

The College of Medical Evangelists gives a four-year medical course based on three years of college work; and the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary offers one year of graduate class study above the regular college degree courses.

Part 2 of Section 1—Intermediate Schools—includes some schools doing eleven grades of work and even a few carrying classes in the twelfth grade, but which are not organized as regular academies. Schools with less than ten pupils above the eighth grade are not generally listed, but the number of secondary students in intermediate schools not shown in the detailed report is given in the total designated, "Pupils above eighth grade in Elementary Schools." Only pupils above the eighth grade are considered secondary students.

Information here shown for buildings and school facilities, student capacity and enrollment, and the number of teachers and other employees, is given as of about February, 1946, after the opening of the second semester of the school year. The number of graduates and students entering denominational work are for the school year ending in May or June, 1945.

(b) The "capacity" of schools is the number of students that may be accommodated in classes, and does not refer to dormitory or boarding space provided. Buildings and student capacity of academies connected with colleges are included in the college figures.

(c) The number of teachers in elementary schools connected with colleges and secondary schools is included with other church school teachers
