The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**Driver:** Mikkel Jensen

**Time (fact):** 17:58

Session: Qualifying Hypercar & LMP2

Fact: Caused a red flag

Offence: 10.2.1 of WEC Sporting Regulations and 10.2.2

**Decision:** The car Nr. 93 will start from the back of the grid and the fastest driver, M. Jensen, will

take the start of the race.

## Reason:

The stewards determined that car 93 caused a red flag during the qualifying session. Taking into consideration the fact that car 93 had not set any lap time at the moment it caused the red flag, the stewards decided that car 93 will start the race from the back of the grid with the fastest driver of all Free Practice sessions, M. Jensen, taking the start.

According to Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art.16.2.6 of 2022 WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
