| Property Description | This is a highly decorated niche housing a statue of the Madonna and Child holding a scapular. The baldachin above the statue is supported by angels and is decorated with cherubs and has a cross on top. On the mensola the Carmelite coat of arms is sculpted in low relief. It is surrounded by spiral designa and floral motifs. It was created by Salvatore Dimech in 1855, influenced from the Nazarenes. It replaced a mid-18th century statue which is now kept in the courtyard of the adjacent Carmelite friary. It has recently beed installed with electrical lighting in the form of bulbs. There is also a bulb in the shape of a flame fixed to the base of the statue beneath a cherub in low relief. |
