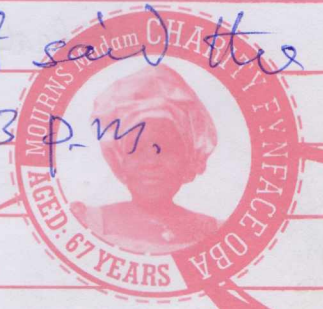
As Healths emerged 1st, the C.D. officers led by Ofiagu were shown site for the Health Centre, which they expressed their joy for.
