Outline Description	The chapel of the Annunciation is very old. Works on the building of the chapel started in 1460 which then torn down and rebuilt in 1658.
Property Description	The chapel is simple is box-like in shape. The facade is elevated by means of low plinths that support flat pilasters. These pilasters end the facade and rung along the entire height of the chapel. The upper part of the facade is topped by flat-ending triangular that is topped by a bell cot. The bell cot has elongated scrolls on the sides and a Cross on its apex. Jutting out from the facade there are two water spouts. The main door along the main facade has a thin stone moulding along its perimeter. The decoration above the main door reaches its apex with scrolls and bulky hanging pendent which is topped by a flat cornice. The same decoration programme is also seen on the side door.
