Entry Fee

Eligible player wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association (From India) must follow a different process to international entries.

The last date of entering the tournament by Indian Registered players is Tuesday, 16th August, 2022. No entry will be accepted from the hosting Member Association of this day.

The following entry fees shall be charged to entries from India:

Singles: INR 2,000 (Per player) Doubles: INR 3,000 (Per pair)

Prize Money & Medals

Total Prize Money of US\$ 15,000 (subject to withholding taxes as per regulations of Government of India. Present minimum rate is 20.60%) will be distributed at the Prize Giving Ceremony, copy of passport is required for verifications purposes.
