





- You may choose to take an inexpensive taxi or mototaxi to/from work daily or ride your own moto (scooter)





- teaching experience as a certified teacher will be evaluated for plcmt on grid
- Note: salaries are commensurate with low cost of living; many teachers report savings of at least 30% after annual vacation travelling

Tchr Comp Pkg, Cont'd...

- Airfare
 - Return flight pd from/to home each yr in 2-yr contract
- Accommodations
 - Provided for or an allowance of \$6,600/yr.
 - Single or shared furnished apartment or townhouse
- Health Insurance
 - Blue Cross basic policy to max \$1,000 annual premium
 - Sick leave allotment 10 days/yr
- Settling Allowance
 - One-time \$600

Tchr Comp Pkg, Cont'd...

- Benefits
 - Free use of Maple Leaf Centre facilities, e.g. Outdoor pools, gymnasium, movie theatre, bowling lanes, etc.
 - 6 full weeks of holiday time throughout the academic year plus summer break
 - One dependent child of teacher can attend tuition-free

Teaching/Prep Time

- Work week = 35 hours incl. 40 min prep; +40 min lunch
- Instruct two after-school co-curricular classes/wk
- Most timetables are M-F between 8:30-3:00;
- Some teaching may be required in the Maple Leaf Centre in addition to the academic program to provide full timetable

Entry Visa and Work Permit

- CIS will assist you in getting your 3-mo.
 entry visa
- CIS will assist you upon arrival in getting your work permit
- VN govt requires you undergo a medical upon arrival

Considerations

- Leave of absence from Ontario employment
- Canadian Residency Status for income tax purposes
- Ontario Teacher Pension Plan effect
- Two-year commitment in Vietnam
- Adjustment to culture in Vietnam

If Employment Offer is made by CIS

- Review sample teacher contract provided
- Sign and return to CIS the Employment Offer-binding
- Research recommended immunizations
- Provide acceptable police check
- Provide letter of good health
- Sign DSBN Waiver and Acknowledgment that the employment contract is solely with CIS; not DSBN
- Notarize and take copies of key education documents
- Ensure passport is current
- Attend scheduled DSBN new-teacher orientation
