This includes restrictions of certain colours for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, 15 September 2022 at 23:59 hrs BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.
Online Entry – Hosting Member Association Entries	 Eligible player wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association must follow a different process to international entries. Entries of Indonesia players ONLINE to si.pbsi.id not later than Tuesday, 6 September 2022.
Withdrawals	The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14. Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section). Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5). Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal. General Instructions:

1. Entry requirements:

ONLY Fully Vaccinated Players and Officials, with Vaccination Record Cards, are allowed to enter Indonesia.

Passengers should fill the Traveler's Health Declaration before arrival and download application PeduliLindungi and register your COVID-19 vaccine certificate.

** If you plan to fly domestically from Jakarta to Malang, please pay attention to below additional requirements :

Domestic travelers traveling by air, sea, land transportation modes using private or public vehicles, crossings, and intercity trains from and to regions throughout Indonesia, must comply with the following provisions:

- Domestic travelers who have received the third dose of vaccination (booster) is not required to show a negative result of the RT-PCR test or rapid antigen test;
- Domestic travelers who have received only the first dose or the second dose of vaccination are required to show a negative result of the RT-PCR test whose sample is taken within 3 x 24 hours before departure;
- Domestic travelers with special health conditions or comorbid diseases that prevent them from receiving vaccinations are exempt from the vaccination requirements, but must show a negative rapid antigen test result whose sample is taken within 1 x 24 hours or a negative RT-PCR test result whose sample is taken within 3 x 24 hours before departure as well as attach doctor's certificate from a Government Hospital stating that the person concerned has not and/or is unable to take part in the COVID-19 vaccination

2. Those who need PCR tests to return to their respective countries can arrange it with the organization during the event (payment will be the person's full responsibility).

3. Insurance

Those athletes and officials who are arriving in Indonesia are advisable to have covid-19 and international insurance for any incident.

Please be aware that the tournament takes place during the current pandemic situation with COVID-19. The conditions for hosting the tournament, as well as hygiene, sanitary and preventive measures will be determined by the local authorities and BWF at all times.

All participants are required to follow the rules and guidelines of the BWF, LOC and local authorities as a condition for participating in the tournament. If the local authorities require it, each participant may have to deliver a responsible declaration before participating in the tournament. Stay at the official hotel provided by LOC.

Should the event be cancelled with short notice by the country's authorities, due to the COVID-19 situation, beyond the control of both Badminton World Federation, Badminton Asia and/ or the local organizers, neither of them will be liable for any costs related to travelling or accommodation made by players/officials for this event.

A COVID-19 RT-PCR Test during the tournament is not mandatory for Super 100 Tournaments for players, team officials, and selected tournament staff and volunteers.
