All items which the subject refused to complete should be recorded as R for "Refused"

All other missing data for specific test items or for total scores should be coded as follows:

- H for "pHysical problem"
- C for "Cognitive / Behavioral Problem"
- O for "Other Problem"

MMSE:

<u>Page 4 of the following chapter</u>: Under "Orientation of Place", the Boston Field Center will be scoring 2 points for "City" and will not be querying for "County".

<u>Page 7 of the following chapter</u>: Under "Registration", in order to achieve as close to a 3-minute delay as possible, following the registration of three items, examiners should administer "WORLD" backwards and then move onto the Pentagon task. Then administer the recall portion of the test.
