A. Perpetrator:

No specific person or persons were identified as an alleged maltreater. This investigation does not support a finding of child abuse/neglect by any particular staff member. However, there are concerns with respect to risk factors that impact a child's safety and well being.

B. Administration/Agency:

Alldredge Academy's administration needs to verbally share the outcome of this investigation with staff. Further, Alldredge Academy should consider taking corrective action with respect to risk reduction as it relates to child safety and supervision and children?s rights. Prior to admission, supervision should be specifically defined to families placing children at Alldredge Academy (i.e. eyes on, periodic checks, night time arrangements, etc...). Children need to have adequate shelter from natural elements (i.e. winter temperatures, snow, rain, etc..). Sanitation issues should be addressed (i.e. access to a port-a-potty and toilet paper, clean water collection devices, etc...). Equipment needs to be kept in working condition (clothing should be free of holes, sleeping bags zip the entire way, etc..). Nutrition should meet the recommended daily

dietary allowance. Child isolation should not be permitted (i.e. solo shelters, prohibiting verbal communication for extended time frames, prohibiting peer interactions, etc..). Children have a right to communicate with significant others outside of the program including the rights to request assistance if he/she feels unsafe and/or believes his/her rights have been violated. Alldredge may want to consider providing clients with a list of their rights and responsibilities. Finally, Alldredge Academy has a duty to inform parents of any and all incidents of aggression, restraint, injury (regardless of self infliction), AWOL, etc. in a timely manner. In closing, Alldredge Academy displayed poor judgement with respect to their treatment and assessment of a Following two known attempts at self harm (AWOL and self inflicted wound) was still placed in an unsupervised situation. The person(s) making this decision did not consult with others familiar with such as his family, physician, mental health provider or even the person who referred to the program. (see Inv. Notes)

C. Programmatic:

was moved outside where he was laid flat and checked for vitals. Staff provided emergency care and transport including back board, 4 wheeler and truck to reach the road and meet the ambulance. Staff members went to the hospital and stayed with until his parents arrived.

B. Administration/Agency:

(1) Administration needs to develop a more comprehensive policy and procedure manual that encompasses and anticipates many of the behaviors of the children placed in their program. Such behaviors would include (but not be limited to): suicide attempts, physically acting out toward staff and/or children, verbal threats, psychiatric diagnoses, medication side effects, etc. (2) Administration should begin working immediately with all necessary licensing entities to bring their program under total compliance to guidelines mandated by West Virginia law. (3) Administration needs to develop training that encompasses the more extensive policy and procedure manual directed in B1 and assure ALL staff are trained fully before they begin working with these youth. (4) Administra-

tion should immediately begin cooperating fully with law enforcement by filing runaway petitions (as

directed by law enforcement) when youth are on runaway (staff have apparently refused to do this in the

past because they don't want any sort of "record" for these kids. However, this is against Alldredge

policy, since in the forms signed by the parents, it states that the agency will do whatever is necessary

to assist law enforcement in apprehending these runaways). (5)

policy to assure that law enforcement is notified (when a child has pending charges) BEFORE the child

Is discharged from the program

C. Programmatic:

Alldredge Academy currently lacks specific program components and corresponding procedures which are required by WV Code for any "facility" which "means a place or residence, including personnel, structure, grounds and equipment used for the care of a child or children on a residential or other basis for any number of hours a day in any shelter or structure maintained for that purpose." Such a "facility" is required to have a Child Care License.





are found to hold some culpability as it relates to the extent of the injury because neither staff appear to have the medical background to make a determination about the extent of any injury, and should have had the child seen by an appropriate medical person once any abnormality (puffiness, discolorization, consistent complaining of pain, etc.) occurred. I also believe that holds some culpability in regard to this injury because she failed to seek a medical specialist as directed by the family (especially with continual complaint of pain and crawling on the floor which she determined to be manipulation) and did not fill or administer prescriptions given by the local doctor.

The Administration/Agency is also culpable in that they have failed to develop policies and implement procedures to adequately and safely respond to medical situations, both emergent and routine.	ł

B. Administration/Agency: 1. Administration should review with they should have reported the puffiness and discolorization immediately to the appropriate medical person to have his foot evaluated. (2) Alldredge needs to develor a written policy regarding notification of parents concerning any medical condition/treatment affecting their child. Staff responsibilities must also be defined and designated. (3) Policies and Procedures should also be developed and implemented pertaining to the immediate referral of medical situations to the appropriate medical specialist (4) Administration should review with staff their need to allow access of the children to their parents when requested and assure that such access is granted. (According to Mr. Wells, parents are never denied access to their children. However, this seems to have occurred at one point when requested to speak with her son and it was quite a bit of time before she was finally allowed to speak with him.)
C. Programmatic:
The administration needs to develop detailed, written, specific policies and procedures for their program that encompasses all aspects of the program and anticipates issues (both medical and non-medical)that may arise within the program and the procedure to deal with such issues.
