



BACKGROUND: FOREST HILL STATION

Forest Hill Station will be an underground station located at the Bathurst Street and Eglinton Avenue West intersection. The station's name comes from the neighbourhood in which it is situated, and to differentiate it from the existing Bathurst Station on the TTC's Line 2.

TIMELINE

- Construction began in 2016 with the commencement of piling works and utility relocation.
- The first concrete roof pours took place in early 2018, with more scheduled throughout 2019.
- The station will be completed in 2021.

KEY FEATURES

- Two station entrances: one on the northeast corner of Eglinton and Bathurst, and the other on the north side of Eglinton, west of Bathurst
- 60 outdoor bicycle parking spaces
- Retail spaces at street level in the northwest entrance
- On-street connections to TTC buses

STATION CONSTRUCTION

- Forest Hill Station is being constructed using the top-down construction method: excavation has started, and will be covered by a concrete roof with permanent roadway on top. Excavation and station box construction will continue below while traffic flows on the surface.
- To advance the station's construction schedule, a temporary traffic bridge was hoisted into place over the active construction site on the south side of the road in mid-2018. This allowed north-south traffic to continue flowing while work occurred underneath.
