ABOUT THE WTA AWARDS

WTA Media Awards: Annually the international tennis media votes on Player of the Year, Doubles Team of the Year, Most Improved Player, Most Impressive Newcomer and Comeback Player of the Year.

Peachy Kellmeyer Player Services Award: Named after long-time WTA employee and International Tennis Hall of Famer, the Peachy Kellmeyer Player Services Award recognizes the player who has done the most to support her fellow players through the WTA Players Council and other initiatives. The award is voted on by the players.

Karen Krantzcke Sportsmanship Award: Awarded to the player who best displays professionalism, attitude and sense of fair play. The award is named in honor of former Australian tennis player Karen Krantzcke. The award is voted on by the players.

WTA Diamond Aces Award: The WTA Diamond Aces Award is named for the late WTA trailblazer Jerry Diamond and is awarded to the player who gives the most to promote the game of tennis on and off the court. The award is based on a point system that is tallied from points earned throughout the season.

WTA COACH OF THE YEAR

The **WTA Coach of the Year** award recognizes the winning coach for success on the court, but also for serving as an ambassador of the sport and bringing coaching to the forefront of the game. Previous winners of this award include Sascha Bajin (2018, Osaka), Craig Tyzzer (2019, Barty), Piotr Sierzputowski (2020, Swiatek) and most recently, Conchita Martinez (2021, Muguruza).

2022 WTA RANKING SYSTEM

The WTA rankings are based on a 52-week, cumulative system. A player's ranking is determined by her results at a maximum of 16 tournaments for singles and 11 for doubles.

During the 2020 and 2021 seasons, a revised ranking system was introduced. Upon suspension of play due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the WTA Rankings became frozen as of March 16, 2020, allowing ranking points to extend beyond the traditional 52-week window so that a player's world ranking would not be impacted due to the suspension. Since the implementation of the frozen rankings, the WTA Tour's Players' Council and Tournament Council underwent an extensive review of the ranking process in order to identify the necessary adjustments upon returning to play. In order to balance fairness and flexibility for all players, the WTA Rankings will generally follow the "Better of 2019 and 2020" point model, in alignment with the ATP Tour.

Traditionally, the tournaments that count towards a player's ranking are those that yield the highest ranking points during the rolling 52-week period. They must include points from the Grand Slams and WTA 1000 tournaments (Indian Wells, Miami, Madrid, Beijing); for those players who qualify, ranking points earned at the WTA Finals will count as the 17th bonus tournament.

In order to appear on the WTA rankings, players must earn ranking points in at least three tournaments, or a minimum of 10 singles ranking points or 10 doubles ranking points in one or more tournaments.
