

GRAND DUCHESS DEAD.

Pauline of Saxe-Weimar Expires Suddenly on a Train.

ROME, May 17.—The Grand Duchess Pauline of Saxe-Weimar died to-day. The Grand Duchess started in the afternoon for Florence, but after leaving Rome died of heart disease. The body was taken to Florence.

The death of the Grand Duchess has produced a deep impression in Rome. She had spent many years traveling in Italy, and was a frequent visitor to the Italian Court.
