

And whereas the Government of Karnataka considers that it is desirable to declare the said area, situation and limits of which are specified in the Schedule II below to be a national park by reason of its ecological, faunal, floral, geomorphological or zoological association or importance for the purpose of protecting, propagating or developing wild life therein or its environment.

Now therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 35 (1) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972 (Central Act 53 of 1972) the Government of Karnataka hereby declares its intention to constitute the area, the situation and limit of which are specified in the Schedule II below to a National Park called as 'NAGARHOLE NATIONAL PARK':

SCHEDULE-I

Name of the Districts: Mysore and Coorg. 571.55 Sq. Kms.
Boundary description

- North:—Thithimathi-Anechowkur High road and continued and the eastern boundary of Kachuvanahalli State Forest. Towards South East direction and crossing the Lakshmanthirtha River and continues along the Northern boundary of Veeranahosally State Forest up to Murkal-Hunsur Road.
- East:—The lines continued along the eastern boundary of Veeranahosally State Forest, Mettikuppe State Forest and Kakanakote State Forest and touches Kabini River and Udbur.
- South: From Udbur, the line runs along river Kabini till it touches the Kakanakote-Kymara road and then along Kakanakote-Kymara road upto Kymara.
- West:—From Kymara, the line passes along the 'D' line of Karnataka and Kerala States and the Western boundary of Nalkeri Range Forest Hutghat Range Forest and Arkeri Range Forest till touches the starting point of Thithimathi Anechowkur Road.

Boundary description:

- North.**—Gonikoppa-Hunsur high upto the eastern boundary of Kachuvanahalli and continued along the eastern boundary of Kachuvanahalli S. F. in South-East direction upto Lakshmanathirtha river and continue along the northern boundary of Veeranahosahalli S.F. upto Murkal Hunsur Road.
- East.**—From the above said point the line continue along the eastern boundary of Veeranahosahalli S.F. Metikuppe S.F. and Kakanakote S.F. and touches Kabini Reservoir at Udboor.
- South.**—From Udboor the line continue along the Southern boundary of Kakanakote S.F. upto Bavali where it touches the inter state boundary between Karnataka and Kerala States.
- West.**—From the above point the line continue along the interstate boundary between Karnataka and Kerala States in Northern direction passes through Kymasa upto the point where the western boundary of Nalkeri R.F. touches the said inter State Boundary. Then the line continue along the western boundary of Nalkeri R. F. Hatghat R. F. and Arekere R. F. and joins the starting point at Gonikoppa Hunsur Road.

West:—The line runs from station 1 to 2 towards due almost NW direction over a distance of 46 chains along S W gadi line of Maje Udriya gadi and meets the junction bonds. Then the line runs from station 2 to 3 towards due north direction over a distance of 55 chains, along the gadi line of Maje Udriya gadi and meets the starting station.

Notification No. FFD 195 FWL 82

Bangalore, dated 16th March 1983

Whereas in notification No. AFD 14 FWL 73, dated 4th February 1975 published in Part IV Section 2C (ii) of the Karnataka Gazette dated 10th July 1975, the Government of Karnataka, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (Central Act 53 of 1972) declared its intention to constitute the area specified in the schedule therein, to be Nagarhole National Park.

And whereas the following events have occurred, namely :—

- (a) the period for preferring claims has lapsed and the claims if any, made in relation to any land in an area intended to be declared as Nagarhole National Park, have been disposed of by the State Government; and
- (b) all rights in respect of lands proposed to be included in the Nagarhole National Park have been vested in the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of Section 35 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (Central Act 53 of 1972) the Government of Karnataka hereby specify the limits of the area mentioned in the schedule below which shall be comprised within the Nagarhole National Park and declare that the said area shall be a National Park called as "the Nagarhole National Park" with effect from 1st April 1983.

SCHEDULE

Name of the Districts :—Mysore and Coorg

Area :— 571.55 Sq. Kms.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

North :—Thithimathi—Anechowkur High Road and continued and the eastern boundary of Kachuvanahalli State Forest. Towards South East direction and crossing the Lakshmananthirtha River and continuous along the Northern boundary of Veeramahosally State Forest, upto Murkal-Hunsur Road.

East :—The lines continue along the eastern boundary of Veeramahosally State Forest, Mettikuppe State Forest and Kakanakote State Forest and touches Kabini River at Udbur.

South :—From Udbur, the line runs along river Kabini till it touches the Kakanakote—Kymara road and then along Kakanakote—Kymara road upto Kymara.

West :—From Kymara, the line passes along the 'D' line of Karnataka and Kerala States and the western boundary of Nalkeri Range Forest, Hutghat Range Forest and Arkeri Range Forest till touches the starting point of Thithimathi—Anechowkur road.
