## 2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play)

This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), and BWF World Tour Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.

This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. This includes restrictions of certain colors for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.

After the entry deadline, the BWF Online Group Entry System will send notification to all

















participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries.

Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday, 9 November 2022 at 12:00 hrs BWF Headquarters time.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, 10 November 2022 at 23:59 hrs BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

Entry Fees for international players will be as follows:

- \$100USD for Singles
- \$50USD/player per event for Doubles

All payments must be made Bank Transfer to Badminton Canada by December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. Bank details will be included on the invoice.

Online Entry – Hosting Member Association Entries Eligible players wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association must follow a different process for international entries.

- Entry is open to any current member of Badminton Canada in good standing with a BWF # ID number. Please note that only Canadian players with a BWF # ID registered in the BWF Active Player Database can be entered by Badminton Canada. Badminton Canada is implementing its Online Entry System for this tournament.
- Players who intend to register for this tournament must ensure that they have a working email to receive a payment and entry confirmation email.
- All Canadian players will be required to pay a Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP) fee as requested by Badminton Canada at the time of online registration.

#### Entry Deadline:

The entry deadline for Badminton Canada members is **Tuesday**, **1 November**, **2022 2359 hrs. PST.** No late entries will be accepted.

#### Entry Fee:

• Flat entry fee of \$125 CDN

#### Confirmation of Entry & Payment:

• Registering players will receive an email confirmation generated by the Badminton Canada Online Entry System and it will include: the events entered and for doubles, partners selected as well as the amount paid online.

















• Receipt of payment and entry confirmation email is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

#### Refunds:

- No refunds will be made for withdrawals done after the deadline of Monday, 21 November 2022
- Entry fees will only be refunded for non-placement in the draws.

#### Canadian Entries:

- Canadian entries will be entered into the draws in order based on: BWF ranking, Badminton Canada ranking and random draw by BWF.
- Placement in the draws, including qualifications, is not guaranteed due to the maximum entry limits.

#### Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organizer are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

A limited number of additional accreditations for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of USD\$150, charged to the respective Member Association, and payable at the tournament.

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be USD\$100 on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation.

The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.

Individuals staying at the Tournament Hotel will receive a special pass for tournament transportation.

#### **Medical Services**

Any request for Covid-19 PCR or blood tests for pre-departure will be charged to the individual requesting the test. Fee: \$100 USD

#### **Anti-Doping**

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, complete a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

The tournament host and hosting Member Association accepts no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late or refused visa applications.

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge.

Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into CANADA; the final decision is made by the Government of CANADA.

**COVID-19 Protocols** 

BWF or the host is not responsible for any tournament cost incurred by any participants should the tournament be canceled or postponed by the local authorities in Canada due but not limited to COVID-19 reasons.
