Probably it was not in a book but in a monumental work that the Master of Catherine of Cleves saw the Miracle of Bethesda by the Rohan Master which he utilized for a miniature in the Hours of Catherine of Cleves. The Cleves Master owed to his model not simply the design and the postures but the feelings of pain and grief that they convey.

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
