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DESIGN FOR AN EXPANSIBLE LINK CHAIN FOR WATCH BRACELET OR THE LIKE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edwin F. M. Speidel, a citizen of the United States residing at Cranston, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Expansible Link Chain for Watch Bracelets, or the Like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing,

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of an expansible link

chain for watch bracelets or the like, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof in an extended position; and

Fig. 3 is a side view of one of the links of the expansible link chain.

I claim:
