

PARDON OF ITALIAN SOCIALISTS.

**One Hundred and Twenty Persons Are
to be Benefited by Amnesty.**

ROME, March 13.—The Ministers have decided to recommend to King Humbert that he grant amnesty to those civilians who were convicted by military tribunals for connection with the late riots in Southern Italy and Sicily.

Such action will benefit 120 persons who were condemned to imprisonment in connection with the Socialist riots in Sicily, including Giuseppe de Felice-Giuffrida, Dr. Nicolo Barbato, and Garibaldi Bosco, all of whom while in prison were elected members of the Chamber of Deputies.
