When answering an exam question – have you used the correct exam structure:

- 3 mark P,D,D
- 6 mark P,D,D,D,P,D,D
- 9 mark Pick ONE option, For and against: P,D,D,D,P,D,D and conclusion AJIM
- 12 mark No choice: ,D,D,D,P,D,D and conclusion AJIM

You can always make REVISION notes on topic areas identified as areas for development (like we have been doing for the past few weeks home learning).

You can always self-quiz theme 1 (Y10 content) theme 2 (Y11 content) using the knowledge organiser which can be found under files on teams.

Bring any work back with you on your return to the classroom.

How will I know what to do?

- In Hegarty, click on Revise and select MemRi to complete one quiz.
- Select a lesson either by clicking on **My Tasks** or searching for a clip number in the search bar.
- Watch the video and note the key worked examples in your exercise book.
- Select **Do Quiz**, recording your workings and answers in your exercise book.
- Aim to achieve 80-100%. If you don't achieve this score, then
 watch the video again on the area that needs developing and
 repeat the task.
