What is Education campus?

- A facility established to empower young refugees in Stuttgart.
- The facility has representatives from different government departments that handle matters concerning refugees.

Target group:

- The campus targets natives and young refugees(with or without German knowledge) in Stuttgart
- It's services will be offered to approx. 450 young people.
- ✓ Natives youths will be included to foster integration.



Objective and tasks of the Education Campus

Main objective:

To educate, empower and mentor young people in all aspects of life and create a platform that offers advice to companies interested in integrating refugees into the workforce.

Tasks:

- a) Support **young refugees** and **native youth** with schooling difficulties into vocational schools
- b) Offering language courses to the refugees in preparation for vocational training
- c) Supporting the refugees before and during their vocational training with smart mentoring programs
- d) Guiding companies that are interested in hiring the young people

Significance of the Education campus

- It promotes cooperation among different institutions, companies and the civil society
- It ensures efficient utilization of existing resources.
- Prepares refugees for the job market
- Facilitates refugee integration into the German society.
- It's a transfarable model → can be applied in other municipalities
- A real place where the young adults get the assistance they need
- All the stakeholders offer their resources "win-win situation"



What is the impelling cause for Education Campus?

Driving factors:

- Refugee influx to Germany
- Communication breakdown and lack of co-operation among various institutions responsible for foreigners in Germany.
- Long processing periods for asylum applicants.
- Inadequate work force in Germany
- Availability of resources in Stuttgart



The association was founded on 22.07.16.






Members of the Round Table

Concept development

- A round table project that commenced in oct. 2015
- 5 Sessions

Project planning

- Fundraising by the Community foundation Stuttgart
- Founding the association
- More sessions with the developing team
- Content development

Project execution

- The staff commenced working 04.10.16
- The staff is working on content development
- On going fundraising



Funding

- The community foundation organized a fundraising to cater for the following expenses for the first 3 years:
 - 3 Staff members → Coordinating Team
 - Lease
 - Other expenses
- Enough money was raised to sustain the campus. Among the institutions that contributed were:
 - different companies
 - Foundations and banks around Stuttgart
- The municipal council offered to pay the lease for 3 years.
