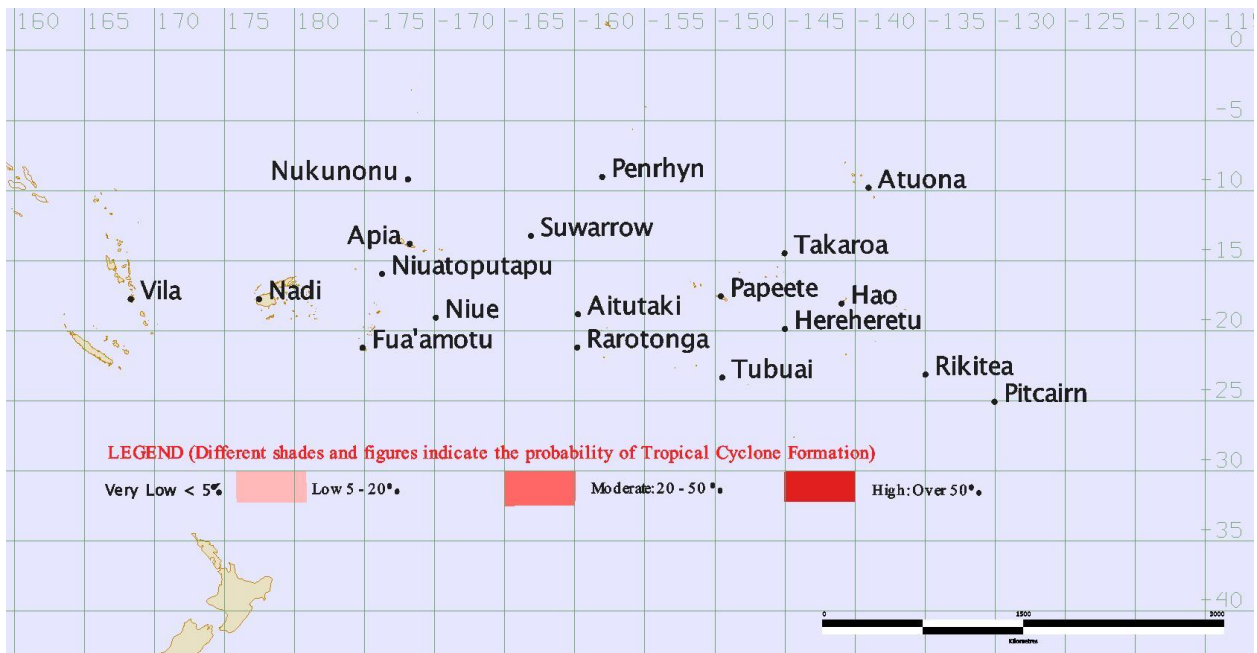
Existing Tropical Cyclones: Nil.

A low pressure system was analysed near 15.0S 172.0W (just to the south of Samoa) at 220000UTC today. It is expected to track west and lie between Vanuatu and Fiji by Monday.

Likelihood of a tropical cyclone formation in the region in the next five days, till Monday 27th February 2023:

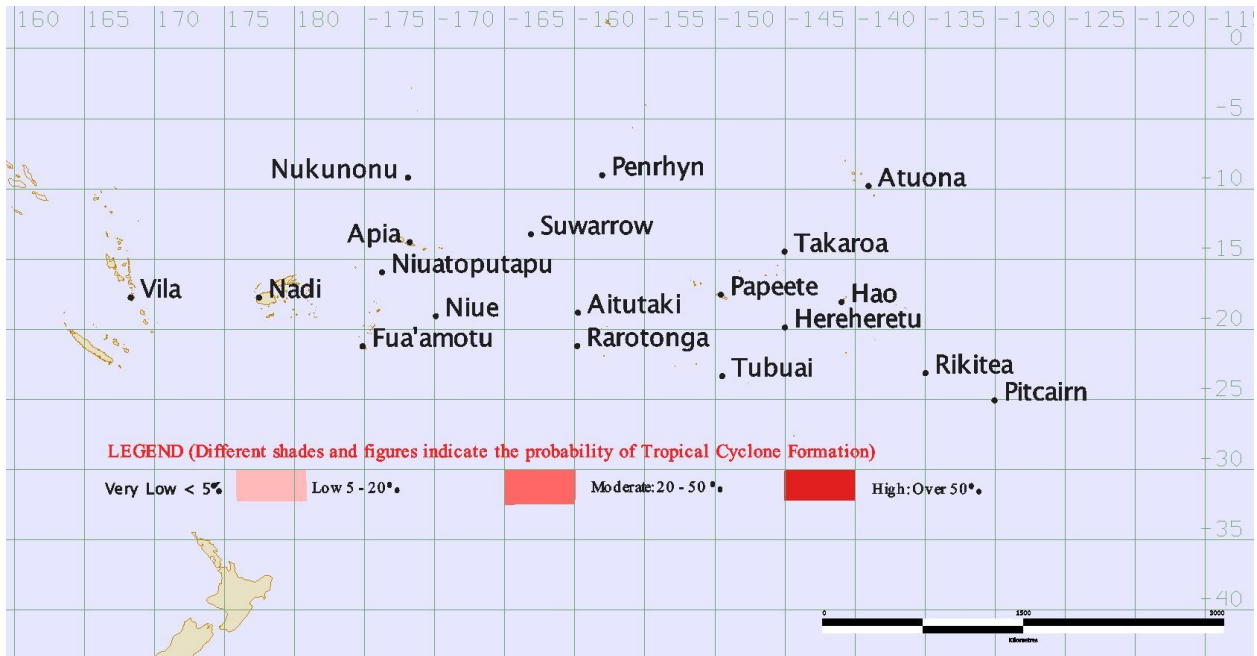
Thursday 23rd February

The potential for formation of a Tropical Cyclone in the region is **VERY LOW**.



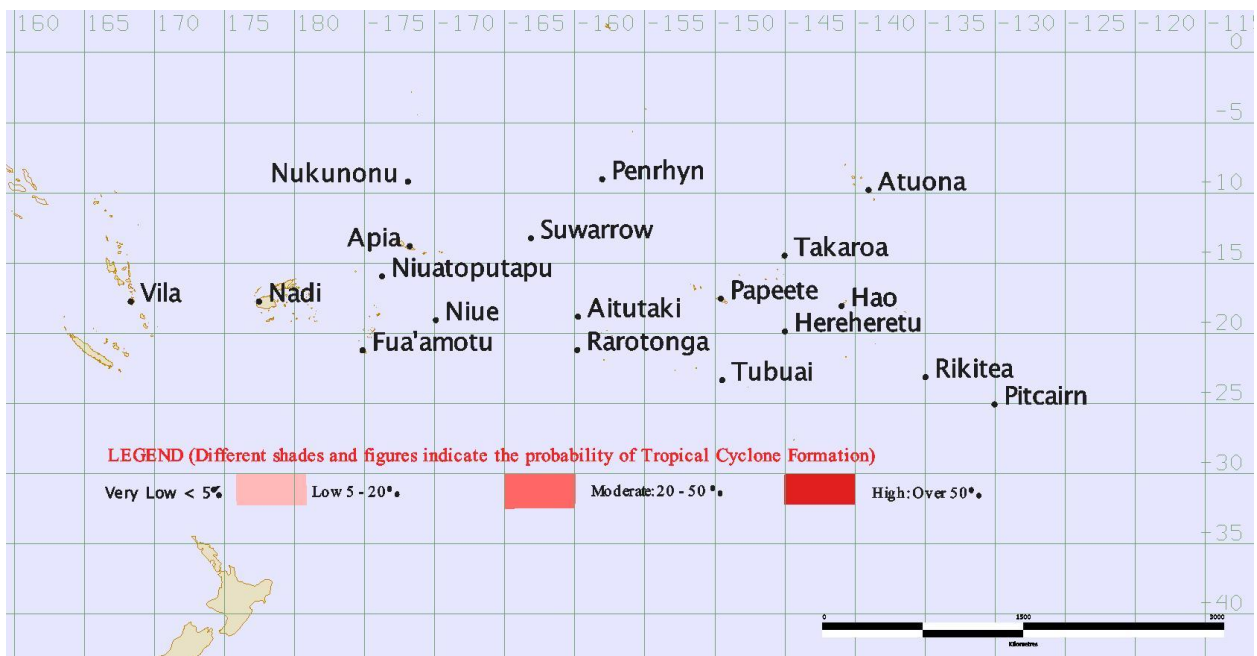
Friday 24th February

The potential for formation of a Tropical Cyclone in the region is **VERY LOW**.



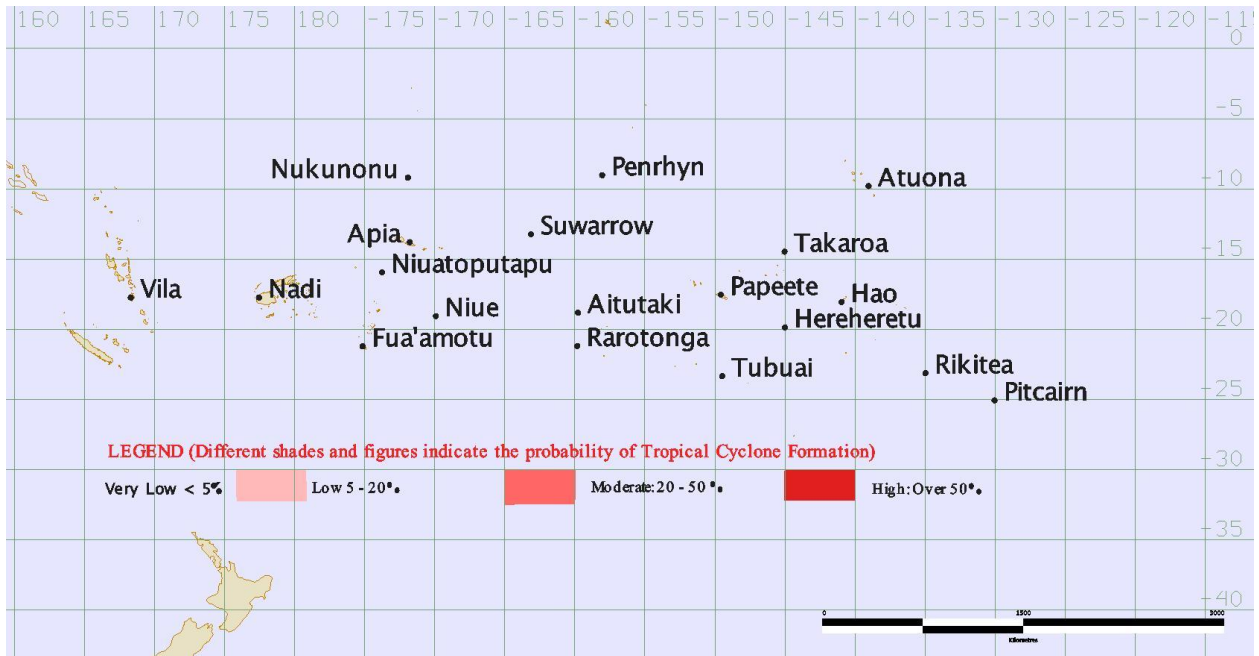
Saturday 25th February
