ABOUT ISRAEL INSIDE/OUT

Israel Inside/Out takes students on an exciting journey through time to learn about the State of Israel, its challenges and accomplishments, and what it means to them. The course begins by presenting the Jewish people's historic connection to the Land dating back to the times of Abraham. Throughout the course the students learn about the current issues facing Israel and the complexities of the conflict in the Middle East from both the Israeli and Palestinian perspectives. This information is presented through films and interviews with the world's foremost experts on Israel and the Middle East.

This course uses entertainment to educate, and each class includes varying combinations of fun and engaging films, discussions, simulations, and activities that train students to think independently. For this history-based course, we present the issues and facts and allow the students to reach their own conclusions. At the end of the course, the students discuss Israel advocacy and are provided with practical tools for action.
