BUCK SHOTS

- The Milwaukee Bucks have won 17 of their last 18 games as they head into Tuesday night's game against the Orlando Magic. The Bucks won for the 17th time in their last 18 games on Sunday with a 117-111 win over the Wizards. Milwaukee is now an NBA-best 46-18 this season and remains in first place in the Eastern Conference standings.
- After Sunday's win in Washington D.C., the Bucks have won their last eight road games dating back to Jan. 23, which is now tied with the 76ers (Dec. 31-Feb. 3) for the longest road winning streak in the NBA this season. Overall, this is tied for the seventh-longest road winning streak in franchise history and is the longest since winning eight straight road contests between Nov. 10 and Dec. 21 in 2019-20. The Bucks enter tonight's game with the third-best road record in the league this season at 19-12.
- The Bucks have won their last 13 games against the Magic dating back to Nov. 1, 2019, which is tied with their 13-game winning streak against the Kings for their longest active winning streak against an opponent. Milwaukee is 2-0 against Orlando so far this season and has already assured itself of its seventh consecutive season series win.
- The Bucks dished out 30 assists in both games of their back-to-back last weekend, just the second time this season that they've recorded 30+ assists in consecutive games (Dec. 5-7). Milwaukee is now 9-1 in games with 30+ assists this season, with five of those games coming after Jan. 23 when they have won 17 of their 18 games.
- Jevon Carter tallied his fourth 20-point game of the season in Sunday's win over the Wizards, knocking down a season-high-tying six threes en route to scoring 20 points. Entering this season, Carter had tallied only three 20-point games in the first four seasons of his career combined. In addition to averaging career-highs in scoring, rebounds and assists this season, Carter is also shooting a career-best 42.1% from three, which is now up to 12th-best in the NBA.

MILWAUKEE BUCKS LAST THREE GAME RECAPS

Bucks at Magic - Sunday, March 5 - Capital One Arena - Washington, DC

W, 117-111 – Giannis Antetokounmpo scored 23 points to help the Bucks take a 117-111 victory over the Wizards on Sunday at Capital One Arena. Milwaukee got out to a 17-point lead in the first half and led 59-48 at the end of the second quarter, but Washington scored 32 points in the third quarter to cut the lead to just 83-80. The fourth quarter quickly turned into a battle, with the Wizards retaking the lead just one minute in. Jevon Carter hit a three to tie it at 86 before Washington scored again to pull ahead. Grayson Allen tied the game again with a floating shot and Carter sank another three to regain a 91-88 lead, the Bucks' final lead of the contest. The Bucks pulled ahead 97-92 a few minutes later with help from a three by Allen, but the Wizards held on to keep the game close. Washington remained within five points for the next five minutes until Jrue Holiday made a floating shot to send the Bucks up by seven points. Holiday followed it up with two free throws to give the Bucks a 115-106 lead with 48.3 seconds left and secure the win. In addition to his 23 points, Antetokounmpo also led the Bucks with nine rebounds and 13 assists, while Carter matched his season-high six threes made and scored 20 points. The Wizards were led by Bradley Beal with 33 points.

L, 130-133 – The Bucks fell 130-133 to the 76ers at Fiserv Forum on Saturday for their first loss in 16 games. After two very close quarters of play, the Bucks entered the third quarter with a 59-53 lead. Grayson Allen began to heat up and made six threes during the frame, scoring 20 points and helping the Bucks shoot nearly 70% from three in the third. Milwaukee's offense found its stride in the middle of the third quarter and mounted a 22-10 run to take an 18-point lead, its largest of the contest. Opening the fourth quarter with a 99-85 lead, the Bucks looked poised to extend their winning streak, but the Sixers started to make their comeback. The game was tied at 108 with 6:05 remaining and layups from Giannis Antetokounmpo and Brook Lopez sent the Bucks back up by six points. The Sixers fought back and kept the game within four points until a Philadelphia three gave them a 125-127 lead with just 42 seconds left in the game. While trying to regain the lead, the Bucks were called for a series of fouls that sent the Sixers to the free throw line three times. Milwaukee couldn't overcome the difference and fell just short. Antetokounmpo led the Bucks with 34 points and 13 rebounds, while Jrue Holiday matched his season-high 13 assists and scored 26 points of his own. Brook Lopez also scored 26 points. The Sixers were led by James Harden with 38 points.

W, 118-104 – Giannis Antetokounmpo scored 33 points to lead the Bucks to a 118-104 win over the Nets at Barclays Center on Thursday, their 15th consecutive victory. Brooklyn led solidly for much of the first half, owning a 62-52 lead heading into the second half, but Milwaukee was ready to mount a comeback. The Bucks opened the third quarter with a 12-2 run, tying the game at 64 just two and a half minutes into the frame. The Nets made a quick basket, but Grayson Allen tied the game back at 66 with a driving layup. The Bucks couldn't quite lock down the Nets, who went back up by 10 points, but a 16-7 run from the Bucks brought them back within one point at 82-83. Brooklyn made a free throw to go up by two points before Bobby Portis Jr. hit a fastbreak three that gave Milwaukee the lead. Khris Middleton made two shots and Jrue Holiday hit a last-second layup that gave the Bucks a 91-85 lead heading into the final frame. Milwaukee finished the third quarter shooting 60.7% and never trailed in the fourth, leading by as many as 18 points. In addition to his team-leading 33 points, Antetokounmpo also led the Bucks with 15 rebounds. Holiday led the team with eight assists and scored 14 points, while Middleton scored 18 points and dished out six assists. The Nets were led by Mikal Bridgers with 31 points.

HOLIDAY SEASON IN SALT LAKE – Bucks guard Jrue Holiday was named a reserve for the 2023 NBA All-Star Game, marking the second All-Star of Holiday's career. HEAD COACH MIKE BUDENHOLZER



Mike Budenholzer is in his fifth season as head coach of the Milwaukee Bucks, having led the Bucks to an NBA Championship in 2021, the most wins in the NBA and four playoff appearances in his first four seasons with the franchise.

After taking over as head coach in 2018, Budenholzer has guided the Bucks to a 213-96 (.689) regular season record and a 38-22 (.633) mark in the postseason, which combined, are the most wins in the NBA over the past four seasons. In addition to winning the NBA Championship in 2021 – the franchise's second title and first in 50 years –

Budenholzer has led the Bucks to a top three finish in the Eastern Conference all four seasons, including the top record in the NBA in each of his first two seasons with the team, and two trips to the Eastern Conference Finals (2019, 2021).

Budenholzer has found success in Milwaukee by turning the Bucks into an elite offensive and defensive team. In his first four seasons with the team, the Bucks led the NBA in scoring three times, including the 2020-21 season when they averaged a franchise record 120.1 points per game. Defensively, Milwaukee has led the league in defensive rating twice under Budenholzer and has finished in the top 10 in three of his four seasons.

Budenholzer reached his 100th and 200th wins with the Bucks faster than any coach in franchise history and begins the 2022-23 season in third place on the Bucks' all-time regular season wins list and second on the all-time playoff wins list. He currently leads the franchise in both regular season and playoff win percentage. Budenholzer has also earned Eastern Conference Coach of the Month honors five times as coach of the Bucks (Jan. '19, Feb. '19, Dec. '19, Jan. '20, Feb. '23) and was selected to coach Team Giannis in the 2019 NBA All-Star Game.

Entering his 10th season as an NBA head coach, Budenholzer is a three-time winner of Coach of the Year, earning the honor in the 2014-15, 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons. In 2014-15 with the Atlanta Hawks, Budenholzer won the Red Auerbach Trophy as the NBA's Coach of the Year and in 2018-19 with the Bucks, he again won the Red Auerbach Trophy as the league's Coach of the Year, in addition to being named the Michael H. Goldberg National Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year, which is voted on annually by the NBA's head coaches. Budenholzer was then named a co-recipient of the Michael H. Goldberg National Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year, along with Oklahoma City's Billy Donovan, following the 2019-20 season. The 2014-15 and 2018-19 seasons were Budenholzer's first with the Hawks and Bucks, respectively, where he earned Coach of the Year honors after leading both teams to 60 wins and appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals.

Budenholzer became the 16th head coach in Bucks history on May 17, 2018, bringing more than 20 years of NBA coaching experience to Milwaukee, having been part of coaching staffs that won four NBA Championships. He came to the Bucks from Atlanta where he compiled a 213-197 (.520) record in his first five seasons as a head coach with the Hawks from 2013-18. He was named NBA Coach of the Year following the 2014-15 season after he led the Hawks to a franchise-high 60 wins and an appearance in the Eastern Conference Finals. Atlanta made the playoffs in four of Budenholzer's five seasons with the team.

Prior to joining the Hawks, Budenholzer spent the previous 19 seasons with the San Antonio Spurs, including the final 17 seasons as an assistant coach, where he was part of one of the most successful eras in NBA history. As an assistant coach with the Spurs from 1996-2013, Budenholzer helped lead San Antonio to a league-best 908-438 (.675) record and NBA Championships in 1999, 2003, 2005 and 2007. Budenholzer spent his first two seasons with the Spurs as a video coordinator before becoming an assistant coach in 1996. He also served as the team's Summer League head coach on numerous occasions and was an advance scout for Team USA for the 2004 Olympics.

A native of Holbrook, Arizona, Budenholzer is a 1993 graduate of Pomona College where he received a bachelor's degree in politics, philosophy and economics and was a four-year letterman in both basketball and golf. Following college, Budenholzer played professionally in Denmark for the Vejle Basketball Klub, averaging a team-high 27.5 points per game during the 1993-94 season, while getting his start in coaching, serving as the head coach for two different teams in the Vejle system.
