The Office of the Commissioner for Public Appointments (OCPA) has appointed <u>Adam</u> <u>Heppinstall KC</u> to lead on its consideration of the public appointment process that led to the appointment of the BBC Chair in February 2021. This follows the <u>recusal of William</u> <u>Shawcross</u>.

This will be carried out under the <u>Public Appointments Order in Council 2019</u> - to provide assurance on whether the appointment process was conducted in line with the government's <u>Governance Code for Public Appointments</u>.

Adam Heppinstall KC will be supported by OCPA officials, and the findings and any recommendations will be published on the OCPA website in due course.
