Doug Price (PhD 1975 University of Michigan) is Weinstein Professor of European Archaeology and Director of the Laboratory for Archaeological Chemistry at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He also holds appointments as 6th Century Chair in Archaeological Science at the University of Aberdeen and Guest Professor at the Center for Textile Research at the University of Copenhagen. Fieldwork has focused on eastern Denmark over the last 30 years. Current excavations are concerned with the beginnings of agriculture on the island of Zealand, Denmark. A second area of interest involves the use of isotopes of strontium, lead, carbon, and oxygen in human tooth enamel to look at questions of prehistoric migration. Projects in the North Atlantic, Central America, Central Europe, China, and the Southwest US are underway. The Laboratory for Archaeological Chemistry is also involved in the chemical analysis of ceramics, bone, soils, and other archaeological materials from around the world.
