MILLER CABINET

INTRODUCTION

Arthur Daniel Miller was named interim leader of the New Democratic Party of British Columbia on August 21, 1999 and was sworn in as Premier August 25, 1999, taking over from Glen Clark. He was first elected to the Legislative Assembly in the general election of October 22, 1986, while the New Democratic Party was still in Opposition. He served in the Harcourt cabinet between 1991-1996 as Minister of Forests and Minister of Skills, Training and Labour. The New Democratic Party of British Columbia was re-elected under Clark's leadership in the general election May 28, 1996. Dan Miller also served in the Clark Cabinet between 1996-1999 as Minister of Employment and Investment, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, Minister of Small Business, Tourism and Culture, Minister of Energy and Mines, Minister Responsible for Northern Development, and Deputy Premier. The first session of the 36th parliament opened June 25, 1996. The second session opened March 24, 1997 and the third session opened March 26, 1998.

The choice of dates for the commencement and termination of a position is not straightforward because an announcement may occur on one date and be confirmed officially on a different date. Generally the "official" date has been used in this document, with footnoted references to any other date(s) involved. If, there was no Order in Council (OIC) or other official notice specifically naming the minister involved, the announcement date has been used.

Mr. Dosanjh was sworn in as Premier on February 24, 2000. OIC 237/2000 dated February 24, 2000 continued all designations of officials in Executive Council. Mr. Dosanjh's cabinet was sworn in February 29, 2000 per OIC 239/2000. For the purposes of this document, the final date of service for cabinet ministers in the Miller administration is February 24, 2000 - the date Mr. Miller's successor, Ujjal Dosanjh, was sworn in as Premier.
